EAST AFRICAN COMMUNITY CUSTOMS UNION

LEGAL NOTICE

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred to the Council of Ministers by Article 12(3) and 39(c) of the Protocol on the Establishment of the East African Community Customs Union, the Council has approved the stay of application of the EAC Common External Tariff (CET) on 38,000 Metric Tonnes of sugar falling under Tariff Codes 1701.11.90, 1701.12.90, 1701.91.00 and 1701.99.90 imported into the Republic of Rwanda within a period of six months.

The import duty rate of 0% shall apply during the six months of stay of application of the EAC Common External Tariff (CET) and sugar imported from the Republic of Rwanda into other EAC Partner States shall attract the import duty rates specified in the EAC Common External Tariff.
