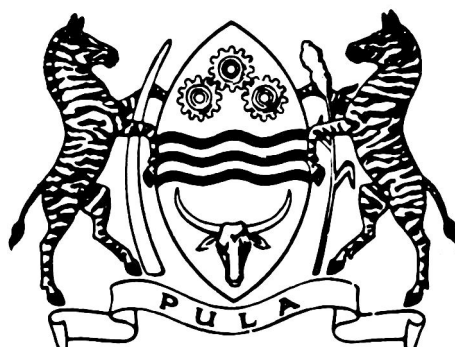

(Cap. 02:07)

Establishment of Polling Districts and Polling Stations

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Supervisor of Elections by section 5 (1) of the Electoral Act, notice is hereby given that each constituency referred to in the Schedule hereto has been divided into polling districts and one or more polling stations in each polling district have been established, the name and description of the boundaries of each such polling district are set out under the name of the constituency in the first and second columns respectively of the Schedule and the situation and name of each polling station are set out in the corresponding entries in the third and fourth columns respectively of the Schedule.
