CONSTITUTION OF BOTSWANA

Authorization to Exercise Functions of Office of President

TO: THE HONOURABLE FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE, M.P., VICE-PRESIDENT AND MINISTER OF FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT PLANNING.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 36 (1) of the Constitution that whenever the President is absent from Botswana or considers it desirable so to do by reason of illness or any other cause he may, by directions in writing, authorize the Vice-President to discharge such of the functions of the Office of President as he may specify, and the Vice-President may discharge those functions until the President's return to Botswana or the revocation of such authorization, as the case may be;

AND WHEREAS I intend to be absent from Botswana from the 20th May, 1997 and I consider it desirable to issue directions as aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me as aforesaid I authorize you, FESTUS GONTEBANYE MOGAE in your capacity as Vice-President and Minister of Finance and Development Planning, to discharge with effect from 20th May, 1997 all the functions of the Office of President, except —

- (a) the power to dissolve Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 91 of the Constitution;
- (b) the power to appoint to the office of Minister or Assistant Minister in accordance with the provisions of section 42 of the Constitution:

Provided, however, that you can appoint the present Ministers or Assistant Ministers to act in place of any Minister who is otherwise not available;

- (c) the power to remove a Minister or Assistant Minister from office in accordance with the provision of section 43 of the Constitution;

until my return to Botswana or this authority is revoked by me whichever happens first.

1. This Act may be cited as the Extradition (Amendment) Act, 1997.

Short title

2. The Extradition Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), is amended by inserting, in its proper alphabetical place, the following new definition —

Amendment of section 2 of Act 18 of 1990

““designated country” means a requesting country which is declared as a designated country under section 3A, and to which a fugitive criminal may be extradited even though there exists no arrangement between Botswana and that country;”.

3. The Act is amended by inserting, immediately after section 3 thereof, the following new section —

Insertion of new section 3A in the Act

"Declaration of designated countries

3A. (1) For the purposes of this Act, and notwithstanding the provisions of section 3, the Minister may, by order published in the Gazette, declare any Commonwealth country to be a designated country.

(2) An order made under subsection (1) may prescribe what crimes shall be deemed to be extradition crimes for the purposes of the order and of this Act, and may be made whether or not the designated country has made any provision for the extradition of any fugitive criminal from its territory to Botswana.

(3) The Minister may revoke any order made under this section, or remove any country from the list of designated countries where he considers that it would be in the interest of Botswana to do so."
