GOVERNMENT DENTAL SCHOLARSHIPS

It is proposed to award a number of scholarships for courses leading to registrable qualification in Dentistry. Selected candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana to serve in the Ghana Public Service for a period of five years.

Qualifications:

- (a) Candidates must be citizens of Ghana.
- (b) They should not have attained their 25th birthday on 1st October, 1969.
- (c) They must have passed the General Education (or School Certificate/Higher School Certificate Equivalents) in:—
 - (i) five subjects at "O" level including English and another approved language;
 - (ii) three subjects at "A" level from Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Botany (not in association with Botany or Zoology), Mathematics (any of Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Pure and Applied Mathematics).
- (d) They must not be under any bond or similar obligation.
- (e) Students pursuing University courses in Ghana are ineligible.

Note.—Ghanaian students already studying Dentistry in overseas Universities may apply, in which case some relation of (b) and (c) above may be permitted.

Application.—Application forms (C.S.C. Form 39) may be obtained from the Registrar of Scholarships, P.O. Box M.75, Accra and should be returned not later than 21st February, 1970.

GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS IN VETERINARY SCIENCE

It is proposed to award a number of scholarships for a five-year course overseas leading to Membership of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons or its equivalent.

2. Candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana on successful completion of their studies and serve in Government service or as otherwise directed for a period of not less than five years.

5. Candidates must not be more than 28 years old by 1st October, 1970.
