WEST AFRICA EXAMINATION BOARD—ROYAL SOCIETY OF HEALTH
ANNUAL EXAMINATION FOR PUBLIC HEALTH INSPECTORS

The Annual Examination for Public Health Inspectors will be held from 4th to 10th August, 1971 at the following Centres:—

GAMBIA	Bathurst
SIERRA LEONE	Freetown
GHANA	Accra
NIGERIA	Aba, Lagos and Kano

Forms of application for admission to the Examination are available at the Schools of Hygiene in these countries and all applications must be submitted through the *Principals of Schools of Hygiene*. Individual applications will not be considered by the Secretariat.

Fee for examination or re-examination is N¢12.86 which must be sent with the application form.

New applicants are advised that:

(a) They must submit evidence of having been engaged during a total period of at least three years as a Public Health Inspector-in-training, consisting of—

- (i) a certificate signed by the Principal of a training school approved by the Board stating that they have attended full-time the approved course of instruction for Public Health Inspectors at that School; *and*
- (ii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to the effect that they have been in full-time employment of a health authority (excluding such time as may be spent in full-time instruction at school) for a period of not less than six months.

The total time covered by these two certificates to be not less than three academic years; *or*

(iii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to the effect that they have been in full-time employment of an approved health authority as Public Health Inspectors-in-training for not less than three years, and that they have attended for the prescribed period of not less than 300 working hours, the approved course of lectures and demonstrations provided by the authority.

(b) Entries must be made on the prescribed form and must be received by the Honorary Secretary, in Lagos, not later than June 15, 1971.

(c) The sum of N¢2.57 will be deducted if any candidate withdraws from the examination before 21 days to the examination date; examination fees will not be refunded within 21 days of the examination date.

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for the post of Assistant Editor of Debates in the Office of the National Assembly.

Salary.—Ranges 45, 50, 60, 67 (N¢1,488—N¢1,740; N¢1,812—N¢2,124; N¢2,208—N¢2,580; N¢2,676—N¢3,108; N¢3,468—N¢3,984).

There are prospects for accelerated progression along the scales.

Duties.—The Assistant Editor of Debates assists the Editor in the organisation and supervision of the Reporters in the Office of the National Assembly. He edits manuscripts of debates received from Sub-Editors and assists the Editor in re-editing the daily reports and prepares comprehensive indexes to the Bound Volumes of Parliamentary Debates.

Qualifications.—Candidates must possess:

- (a) the West African School Certificate with credit in English or the General Certificate of Education with a pass in English, and
- (b) a Diploma in Journalism from a recognised School with 2 years' journalistic experience, or
- (c) degree of a recognised University.

Serving officers must possess at least 2 years' administrative experience and must not be below the grade of Higher Executive Officer and must have journalistic experience.
