SCHOLARSHIPS SECRETARIAT

GHANA GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS IN FISHERY SCIENCE

It is proposed to award a number of scholarships for a four-year course of training at the Plymouth Polytechnic, School of Maritime Studies, Hull, England, leading to the B.Sc. degree in Fishery Science. The award is to enable candidates qualify for appointment as Fisheries Officer in the Fisheries Department on the salary Range 52-55 (₵2,472-₵3,096).

2. Candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana on successful completion of their studies and serve in the Government Service or as otherwise directed.

3. *Qualifications.*—Candidates must have passed the General Certificate of Education in:

- (i) Five subjects at "O" Level including English Language and Mathematics;
- (ii) and have obtained three passes at the Advanced Level in any of these subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Biology (not in association with Botany or Zoology), Mathematics (any one of Pure Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, Pure and Applied Mathematics).
- (iii) or possess equivalent qualifications.

4. Application forms may be obtained from the Registrar of Scholarships, Scholarships Secretariat, P.O. Box M.75, Accra, to whom they should be returned not later than 4th February, 1975. Copies of Educational Certificates required by the qualifications above must be provided.

5. Persons under any form of bond are not eligible.

SCHOLARSHIPS SECRETARIAT

GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS IN RADIO SURVEYING

It is proposed to award a number of scholarships for a three-year course of training tenable in overseas to enable selected candidates to qualify for consideration for appointment as Assistant Radio Surveyor on the salary Range 45, 50 (i.e. ₵1,488-₵2,124 per annum) in the Shipping and Navigation Division of the Ministry of Transport and Communications.

2. Candidates will be bonded to return to Ghana on successful completion of their course and serve in Government Service or as otherwise directed.

3. Candidates who must be Ghanaians, should:—

- (i) be medically fit;
- (ii) be not more than 25 years of age;
- (iii) possess G.C.E. "O" Level with passes in 5 subjects including English Language, and in addition, have obtained passes in Physics and Mathematics at the "A" Level; or
- (iv) possess an acceptable Telecommunication (Radio) qualification.

4. Application forms may be obtained from the Registrar of Scholarships Secretariat, P.O. Box M.75, Accra, to whom they should be returned not later than *February 26, 1975*. Copies of educational Certificates required by the qualifications above must be provided.

VACANCIES FOR SENIOR VALUATION OFFICERS

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for appointment to the post of Senior Valuation Officer in the Ministry of Local Government.

Qualifications and Experience.—Candidates must—

- (i) be Associate Members of the Commonwealth Institute of Valuers, or the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors, or the Ghana Institution of Surveyors or equivalent professional body, and
- (ii) have had at least 5 years' post-qualification experience in a major Valuation Department or in private practice.

Duties.—

- (i) To be responsible for over-all supervision of valuation programmes in a Region.
- (ii) To give directions as to valuation procedures and principles to be adopted in a Region.
- (iii) To evaluate annual reports submitted by District Heads for submission to the Commissioner of Valuation.
- (iv) To examine the most difficult cases of objections and arrange and preside at Conferences between Departmental Officials and objectors of their representatives.
- (v) To advise Heads of other Departments, Authorities and Institutions in the Region on rating and valuation matters as required.
- (vi) To examine and approve documents and exhibits prepared as evidence in major appeal cases and may conduct some of the appeal cases personally.
- (vii) To instruct on probable future impact of new rating and valuation principles and precedents emanating from Court decisions.
- (viii) To be responsible for over-all administration of a Regional Valuation Office.

Salary.—Ranges 73, 75 (€4,776-€5,676).

Duties and Responsibilities

In general:

Under the supervision of the Chief, Finance and Accounts Section to be responsible for the operation, co-ordination and supervision of the Expenditure Control Unit including commercial claims, payroll and technical assistance activities.

In particular:

To supervise the review of all obligation documents, payrolls and payment vouchers so as to ensure both their legality and with the approved programme and budget;

To supervise the periodic reconciliation of unliquidated obligations;

To supervise the preparation of Value Added Tax reports and requests for reimbursement by the Austrian Government;

To assist in the co-ordination of the computerization of payroll and payment procedures and improvements to the computerized accounting system;

To co-ordinate the work of the Unit with that of other divisions and offices.

Qualifications.—University degree or equivalent academic qualifications with specialization in accountancy or business administration; at least six to ten years' relevant experience at a professional level; experience in electronic data processing desirable. Fluency in English, French, Russian or Spanish essential.
