#### PROCLAMATION.

#### The East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under the East Africa Outlying Districts Ordinance, 1902, I, Sir Edouard Percy Cranwill Girouard, K.C.M.G., D.S.O., R.E., Governor of the East Africa Protectorate, do hereby declare that the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto attached and which are located in the Nyanza Province are excluded from the Native Reserve and Closed Districts as before proclaimed.

#### Schedule.

1. The Uganda Railway line from the point of its entry into the Kisumu Native district at the Likuno river East of Muhoroni to the point where the line enters the Kisumu Township area, including 100 feet either side of the centre of the track, and any extension of the Railway boundary where any landi is situated, and where the boundaries of such landi exceed the Railway boundary.

The Muhoroni Railway Station and Railway boundaries as defined by pillars laid

down by the Railway Department.

3. The Kibigori Railway Station and Railway boundaries as defined by pillars, &c., laid down by the Railway Department, and additional boundaries as follows to include Indian shops and trading stores located outside the Railway Station boundary:—Pole marked A starting at the South-west boundary mark of the Railway to a pole B 200 yards distant in a North-westerly direction along the Railway boundary, thence in a South-westerly direction for 300 yards to a pole C, thence in a direct line South-east for 200 yards, thence the length of the Station boundary to pole **D**, thence in a North-easterly direction to pole **E** against the Station South-east boundary.

The Kibos Railway Station and Railway boundaries as defined by pillars, &c., laid down by the Railway Department and additional boundaries as follows to include Indian shops and trading stores located outside the Railway Station boundary:—Pole marked A starting at the South-west boundary of the Railway to pole **B** 200 yards distant in a Northerly direction along the Railway boundary, thence in a Southerly direction for 300 yards, to a pole **C**, thence in a direct line East for 200 yards, thence continuing East for the length of the Station boundary to pole D, thence in a Northerly direction to pole E against the Station

South-east boundary.

5. That part of the Kisumu district situated North of the Uganda Railway line and defined as follows:—Bounded on the South by the Uganda Railway boundary, on the West by the western limits of the farms occupied on the Kibos river by the Indian cultivators settled at Kibos and the Government farm, on the North by the base of the Nandi Escarpment, defined by cairns and pillars to denote the Southern boundary of the Nandi Reserve, on the East by the track leading from Kibigori Railway Station to the bottom of the Nandi Escarpment (the Kibigori-Kaptumo road).

All the land situated as follows:—North of the Uganda Railway line from a point immediately East of the Kibos river to the boundary line between the Kisumu and Navasha Provinces and following such limits up to the LIKUNO river East of Muhoroni Station.

7. All the land held by the British East Africa Corporation near the Kisumu-Mumias road in the location of Kisumu. The land is fenced and otherwise marked by the Corporation.

8. All the land held by the East Africa Industries Limited at Maseno in the location of Sagan.

#### Under the East Africa Marriage Ordinance, 1902.

In accordance with the provisions of the East Africa Marriage Ordinance 1902, section 6, I hereby give notice that I have licensed the Catholic Mission Mangu, Kyambu district, to be a place for the celebration of Marriges under the aforesaid Ordinance from and after the 4th day of January, 1910.

#### Schedule.

#### Site No. 1, for Camping Ground and Bazaar at the Tugunoon River on the Lumbwa-Kericho Road in the Lumbwa District.

Commencing at a point where the original Lumbwa-Kericho Cart Road crosses the Tugunoon at Beacon No. 1, thence following the said road to a point where the former road meets the present road and to Beacon No. 2, thence following the present road back to the Tugunoon and to Beacon No. 3, thence following the centre of the stream Tugunoon up stream to Beacon No. 1 and to the point of commencement.

#### Site No. 2, Description of Boundaries of Petchu Lelatch Stream Camp and Bazaar Lumbwa-Kericho Road.

Commencing at a point on the Lumbwa-Kericho Road where the Petchu Lelatch Stream crosses the Road and at Beacon No. 1, thence bounded by a line following the centre of said Petchu Lelatch Stream down stream to Beacon No. 2, then by a line running in a southerly direction to the Lumbwa-Kericho Road and to Beacon No. 3, thence by the Kericho-Lumbwa Road to Beacon No. 1, and the point of commencement.

#### Site No. 3, Description of Boundaries of Kemnetu River Camp and Bazaar. Lumbwa-Kericho Road

Commencing at a point on the Lumbwa-Kericho Road where the telegraph line leaves the said road on the North side of the Kamnetu River and at Beacon No. 1, thence by a line following the telegraph line and in a South-Westerly direction to the point where the telegraph line crosses the Kamnetu River and to Beacon No. 2, thence following the centre of the Kamnetu River up-stream to the point where the Lumbwa-Kericho Road crosses the Kamnetu River and to Beacon No. 3, thence by the Kericho-Lumbwa Road to Beacon No. 1, and to the point of commencement.

#### Description of Boundaries of Kericho Government Station Area in Lumbwa Native Reserve,

Commencing at point lying about 6,500 feet East of Kericho Fort and at Beacon No. 1, then proceeding in a North-Westerly direction for two miles cutting the Kericho-Lumbwa Road at the commencement of the "Straight" to Beacon No. 2. then proceeding in a South-Westerly direction for two miles to Beacon No. 3, and then in a South-Easterly direction for two miles to Beacon No. 4, then by a line in a North-Easterly direction for two miles to Beacon No. 1, the point of Commencement.

#### Site No. 1, for Camping Ground and Bazaar on the Kericho-Sotik Road at the Mara Mara River

commencing at a point No. 1, on the main road 150 yards South of the Mara Mara River and running due to East for 195 yards to point No. II. From here the boundary runs due South for 200 yards to point No. III. and from this point due West for 300 yards to the spot No. IV. From here the lines runs due North for 200 yards cutting the road at yards 95 to point No. V: and then due East for 105 yards where it meets point No. 1.

#### Site No. 2, for Camping Ground and Bazaar Along the Kericho-Sotik Road on Kapsita Hill

From point No. I on the main road the boundary follows the road for 300 yards in a Southerly direction for 300 yards to point No. II. from which it follows a Westerly course for 100 yards to point No. III. From here the boundary runs North for 300 yards to point No. IV, and from this spot the line runs East for 100 yards where it joins point No. I.

#### Site, No. 3, for Camping Ground and Bazaar on the Kericho-Sotik Road at Karcherero

Commencing at a point No. I on the main Road the boundary runs in a South-South-Easterly direction for 100 yards to point No. II: and from here it follows a South-South-Westerly course for 300 yards to point No. III. From here it takes a North-North-Westerly course for 200 yards to point No. IV, cutting the main road at the 100th yard. From point No. IV the line runs North-North-Easterly for 300 yards to point No. V, and from here the boundary takes a South-South-Easterly turn for 100 yards where it joins up with the point No. 1.

#### Description of Boundaries of Sub-Station Sotik, Kericho District,

Commencing at a point on the Nyangoris River lying to the South West of the Government Buildings and at Beacon No. 1, thence bounded by a line North for the distance of one mile to Beacon No. 2. thence by a line East for a distance of one mile and crossing the Kericho-Sotik road to Beacon No. 3, thence by a line for the distance of one mile in a Southerly direction to the Nyangoris River and to Beacon No. 4, thence by a line following the Nyangoris River to Beacon No. 1 and to the point of commencement.
