2 Any person contravening the provisions of these Regulations shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Rupees five thousand (5,000/-) or to imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding six months, or to both

3 These Regulations shall be read together with the Martial Law Regulations of the tenth day of December, 1914, and may be administered by any Magistrate holding a subordinate Court of the 1st or 2nd class
