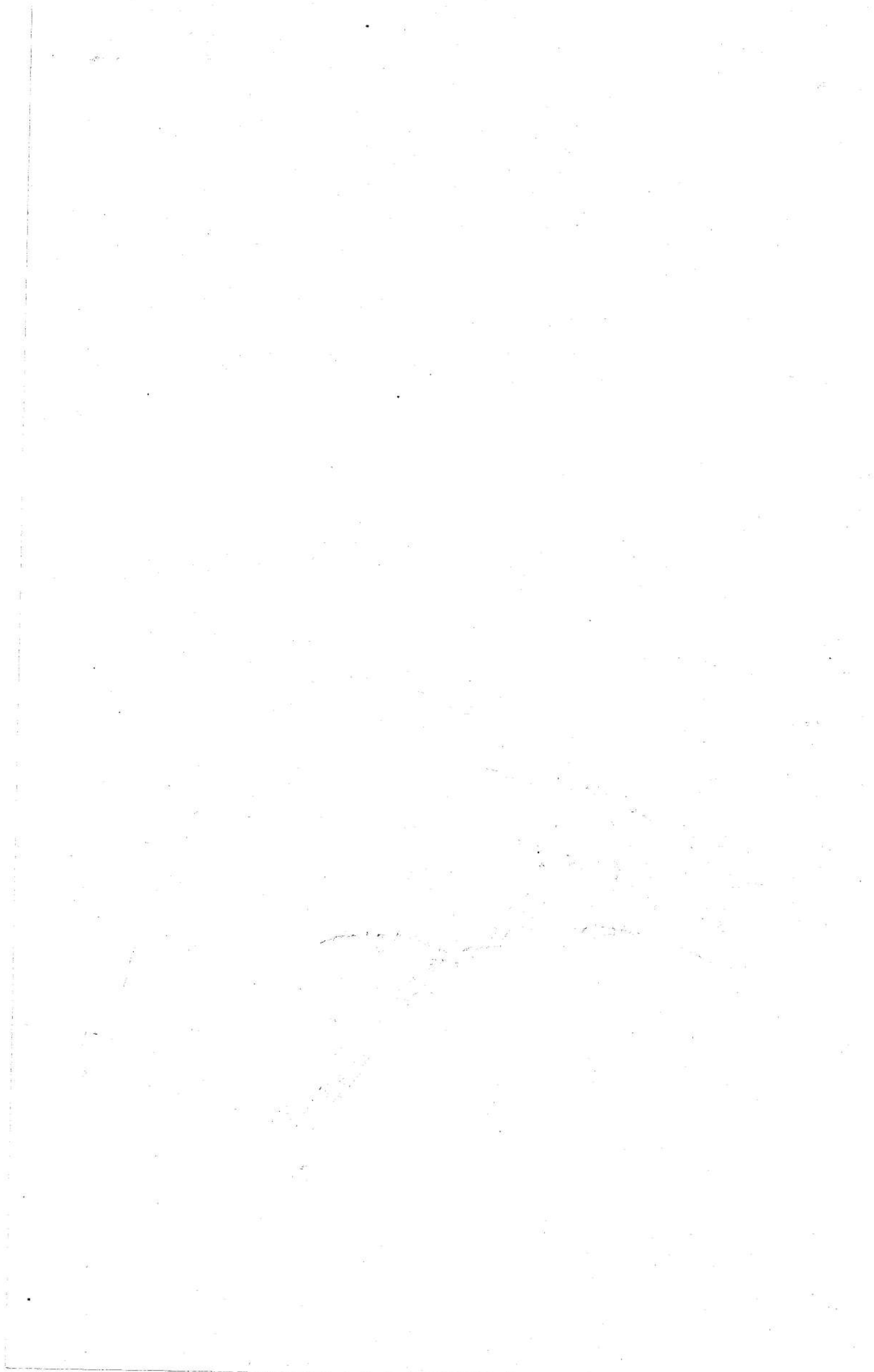

ELDORET.

Portion of Electoral Area.

Commencing at the North-west corner of L.O. No. 795 on the Sossiani River;
 thence bounded by that river up-stream to its junction with the Sergoit River;
 thence by the latter river up-stream to the South-west corner of L.O. No. 886;
 thence by the Southern boundary of L.O. No. 886;
 thence by the Western boundary of L.O. No. 893;
 thence by the South-western boundary of L.O. No. 4488;
 thence by the Western boundary of L.O. No. 901 to the Sergoit or Misikuri River;
 thence by the Sergoit River down-stream to the most Northern corner of L.O. No. 733;
 thence by the Western boundaries of that portion and of L.O. Nos. 3637 and 3639 to the South-west corner of the last portion;
 thence Westerly by part of the Northern boundary of L.O. No. 738 to its North-west corner;
 thence by the Western boundary of that portion to the Nureri River;
 thence by that river and the Nasaiki River which form the Northern boundaries of L.O. Nos. 739, 743 and 742 down-stream to the North-west corner of the last portion;
 thence by the North-west boundary of L.O. No. 742 to its Western corner;
 thence North-westerly by the generally Western boundary of the Uasin Gishu farms to the most Western corner of L.O. No. 745 on Eldalat;
 thence by the South-western boundary of L.O. No. 755 and the Western boundary of L.O. No. 795 to the point of commencement.

 thence by that river up-stream to its junction with the Misikuri River;
 thence by the latter river up-stream to the South-eastern corner of L.O. No. 903;
 thence Northerly by the Eastern boundary of that portion and by part of that of L.O. No. 902 to the North-west corner of L.O. No. 907 (South Elgeyo Forest Reserve);
 thence by the Northern and Eastern boundaries of that portion and part of the Eastern boundary of L.O. No. 908; to a point due East of the South-east corner of L.O. No. 1721;
 thence by a straight line due West to that corner;
 thence by the Southern boundary of L.O. No. 1721 to its South-west corner on the Kapekabush River;
 thence by that river down-stream till it becomes the Nureri River, and by the latter river down-stream to the point of commencement.

POLLING STATION No. 3.

Farm 40, L.O. 700, Uasin Gishu.

Portion of Electoral Area.

Commencing at the most Westerly corner of L.O. No. 742;
 thence bounded by the North-western boundary of that portion to the Nasaiki River;
 thence by that river and the Nureri River which form the Northern boundaries of L.O. Nos. 742, 743, 739, 727, 3653, 3654, 724 and 723 up-stream to the North-east corner of the last portion;
 thence by the Nureri and Kapekabush Rivers which form the North-eastern boundaries of L.O. Nos. 713, 712 and 709 to the South-west corner of L.O. No. 1721;
 thence by the Southern boundary of the last portion to its South-east corner;
 thence by a straight line due East to its intersection with the Eastern boundary of L.O. No. 908 (South Elgeyo Forest Reserve);
 thence by part of that Eastern boundary South-easterly to the South-east corner of L.O. No. 908;
 thence by a straight line South-easterly to the North-west corner of L.O. No. 498 (Eldama Ravine Township Reserve);
 thence by a straight line South-westerly to the most Northerly corner of L.O. No. 4143;
 thence by the generally Eastern boundary of that portion to the Northern boundary of the Londiani-Ravine Road Reserve;
 thence by that Road Reserve boundary to the most Southerly corner of L.O. No. 4143;
 thence in a generally North-westerly or Westerly direction by the Southern or South-western boundaries of L.O. Nos. 4143, 4141, 4361, 4360, 4142, 3850, 3094 and 1860 to the Western corner of the last portion;
 thence by a straight line Northerly to the most Western corner of L.O. No. 1858;
 thence by a straight line still Northerly to the South-west corner of L.O. No. 663 (Outspan);
 thence by the Western boundary of that portion to its North-west corner;
 thence in a generally North-westerly direction by part of the North-eastern boundary of the Tinderet Forest Reserve to the Eastern corner of L.O. No. 1485A;
 thence by the North-western boundary of that portion to its Northern corner on Olessos (Dionyo Lessos);
 thence North-westerly by the generally Western boundary of the Uasin Gishu farms to the point of commencement.

Commencing at the North-west corner of L.O. No. 886 on the Sergoit River;
 thence bounded by the Northern boundaries of that portion and of L.O. Nos. 885 and 3720 to the North-east corner of the last portion;
 thence by the Eastern boundaries of L.O. Nos. 3720 and 3721;
 thence by the Northern boundaries of L.O. Nos. 1558 and 1559/3;
 thence by the Eastern boundaries of the latter portion and of L.O. Nos. 3975, 1561, 902 and 903 to its South-east corner on the Misikuri River;
 thence by that river and the Sergoit River down-stream to the South-western corner of L.O. No. 901;
 thence by the Western boundary of that portion, the South-western boundary of L.O. No. 4488, and the Western boundary of L.O. No. 893 to its North-west corner;
 thence by the Northern boundary of L.O. No. 892 to the Sergoit River;
 thence by that river down-stream to the point of commencement.
