A Bill

Intituled

An Ordinance to Amend the Estate Duty Ordinance, 1918.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Estate Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924," and shall be read as one with "The Estate Duty Ordinance, 1918," hereinafter called "the Principal Ordinance" and with all amendments thereof. Short Title.
- 5 2. Sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion of the word "not" after the words "under a disposition" in the third line of the sub-section. Amendment of Section 12 (2) of the Principal Ordinance.
- 10 3. Sub-section (2) of Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby further amended by deleting the words "twelve months" and substituting therefor the words "three years." Further Amendment of Section 12 (2) of the Principal Ordinance.

Intituled

An Ordinance further to Amend the Registration of Business Names Ordinance, 1918.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Registration of Business Names (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924," and shall be read as one with "The Registration of Business Names Ordinance, 1918" (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Ordinance") and all amendments thereof. Short Title.
- 5 2. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following clauses:— Amendment of Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance.
 - 10 (i) Where the registration to be effected is that of a firm, the age of each partner thereof under the age of 21 years;
 - 15 (j) Where the registration to be effected is that of an individual, the age of such individual if under the age of 21 years.

Provided that where any such partner or individual is of or over the age of 21 years it shall be sufficient for him to state his age as 'full age'."
