THE RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF JUDGMENTS ORDINANCE, 1922.

PROCLAMATION.

E. B. DENHAM.



BY His Excellency Edward Brandis Denham, Esquire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Acting Governor and Commander in Chief of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya.

WHEREAS by Section 5 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Ordinance, 1922, it is enacted that where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislature of any part of His Majesty's Dominions (including countries under His Majesty's protection) outside the United Kingdom for the enforcement within that part of His Majesty's Dominions of judgments obtained in the Supreme Court of the Colony of Kenya the Governor in Council may by Proclamation in the Gazette declare that this Ordinance shall extend to judgments obtained in a Superior Court in that part of His Majesty's Dominions in like manner as it extends to judgments in a Superior Court in the United Kingdom and on any such Proclamation being made this Ordinance shall extend accordingly.

And whereas I am satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the legislature of the Bechuanaland Protectorate for the enforcement within that Protectorate of judgments made by the Supreme Court of this Colony.

And whereas I am satisfied that the Court of Assistant Commissioner or Magistrate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate is a superior court within the meaning of Section 5 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Ordinance, 1922.

Now therefore by virtue of the powers in me vested as aforesaid, having taken the advice of my Executive Council, I do hereby proclaim and declare that the provisions of the said Ordinance are extended to judgments made by the Court of Assistant Commissioner or Magistrate in the Bechuanaland Protectorate.

This Proclamation shall take effect as from the 18th day of March, 1925.
