Owners may be assured that the greatest care is taken of the animals, which on arrival, are moved direct from the railway truck to Tick Free Sheds.

- 4. A charge of Shs. 1/75 per diem is made to cover the cost of keep only; the usual period of detention is 100 days. Experience shows that losses are likely to be heavy, both in importations from Great Britain and South Africa, unless the cattle are immunised, and the cost—which may be estimated at approximately £10 per head—is fully justified; besides which, it should be noted that, during the period of immunisation, the animals improve in condition, get acclimatised, and in the case of bulls, become fit for service without loss of time to the owner.
- 5. The Chief Veterinary Officer, Veterinary Department. Naairobi, should be advised of the arrival of animals for inoculation, and they should be consigned direct to Veterinary Department, Mile 1/16, Thika Railway.
