## A Bill

### Intituled

#### An Ordinance to Apply a Sum of Money for the Service of the Year Ending the 31st day of December, 1926.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as " the Appropriation Ordinance, 1925." Short title.

2. The Public Revenue for the year 1926, and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, are hereby charged towards the service of the year ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, with a sum of Two Million, Three Hundred and Eighty-five Thousand, Six Hundred and Sixty-six pounds. Public Revenue charged.

3. The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied to the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule annexed hereto. Application of money granted.

4. The Treasurer of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby authorised and required from time to time, upon the Warrant or Order of the Governor to pay out of the Revenue and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, for the several services specified in the Schedule, the said sum of Two Million, Three Hundred and Eighty-five Thousand, Six Hundred and Sixty-six pounds, which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six. An Ordinance to Supply a Further Sum of Money  
for the Service of the Period from January 1st,  
1926, to 31st December, 1926.

- Short title.
1. This Ordinance may be cited as “ the Supplementary Appropriation (Railway) Ordinance, 1925.”
- Public Revenue charged.
2. The Public Revenue for the above period and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya are hereby charged towards the service of the period of twelve months ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, with a further sum of Two Million, Seven Hundred and Forty-five Thousand, Eight Hundred Pounds, in addition to the sums provided by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1925.
- Application of money granted.
3. The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied to the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule annexed hereto.
- Treasurer's authority for payment.
4. The Treasurer of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby authorised and required from time to time, upon Warrant or Order of the Governor, to pay out of the Revenue and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate, for the several services specified in the Schedule, the said sum of Two Million, Seven Hundred and Forty-five Thousand, Eight Hundred Pounds, which will come in course of payment during the period of twelve months ending on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-six.

THE RESIDENT NATIVE LABOURERS'  
ORDINANCE, 1925.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on him by the Resident Native Labourers' Ordinance, 1925, His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as "The Resident Native Labourers' (Registers) Amendment Rules, 1925," and shall be read as one with the Resident Native Labourers' (Register) Rules, 1925, hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Rules."

2. Rules 2, 4 and 5 of the Principal Rules are hereby amended by the deletion of the word "stock" wherever occurring therein and the substitution therefor of the word "cattle."

3. The Schedule to the Principal Rules is amended by the deletion of the "Register of Stock" therein and the substitution therefor of the "Register of Cattle" in the Schedule hereto.

THE ROADS PROTECTION ORDINANCE, 1924.

## NOTICE.

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the Roads Protection Ordinance, 1924, it is enacted that the Governor may with the concurrence of the District Road Board or other Local Authority concerned, by order prescribe that any road reserve, or part thereof, or any public road, or part thereof, shall be open to traffic of a particular kind, or shall be closed to traffic of a particular kind, or shall be closed to all traffic.

Now, in exercise of the powers vested in him by the said section, His Excellency the Acting Governor has, with the concurrence of the Local Authority within the meaning of the said section, been pleased

to order that the public road known as the Kisumu-Yala Motor Road, shall be closed to all kinds of wheeled traffic, except the following, namely:—

- (a) Pedal cycles.
- (b) Motor cycles with or without side-car attachments.
- (c) Motor vehicles (excluding motor lorries loaded or unloaded) not exceeding 2½ tons gross weight when loaded and used for carrying passengers only.
