#### THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE.

##### PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of the Diseases of Animals Ordinance (Chapter 157 of the Revised Edition) it is provided that the Governor may at any time by Proclamation declare any area to be an infected area; extend, diminish or otherwise alter the limit of an area declared to be an infected area; declare an infected area to be free from disease; and/or for the purpose of preventing disease prohibit the removal of animals from one district, place or area to any other district, place or area.

And whereas as by Government Notice No. 231, dated the 3rd day of July, 1919, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 13 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Chapter 1 of the Revised Edition), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to depute the person for the time being holding the office of Chief Veterinary Officer to exercise on his behalf the powers conferred upon the Governor by the said Section 4 of the Diseases of Animals Ordinance.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers so conferred and all other powers thereunto enabling me, I hereby declare the following farms to be infected areas for the purposes of the said Diseases of Animals Ordinance:—

## GOVERNMENT NOTICE No. 431.

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE EXPORT  
ORDINANCE.

## RULES.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon him by section 10 of the Agricultural Produce Export Ordinance (Chapter 98 of the Revised Edition), His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as "the Grading of Maize (Amendment) Rules, 1926," and shall be read as one with the Grading of Maize Rules, 1925 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Rules").

2. There shall be added to the Principal Rules the following new Rule 26:—

"26. Notwithstanding anything contained in Rules 4 and 13, and subject to Rule 18, maize for shipment in bulk may be contained in second-hand bags that have been previously used only for maize, provided that:

- (a) before the first part of the consignment is placed on rail notice shall be given to the inspector by the shippers of the quantity of maize to be shipped in bulk, the grade, and the name of the ship on which space has been booked;
- (b) maize railed to the Coast in second-hand bags which is found on arrival by the inspector not to be of the grade previously described by the shipper, shall be re-bagged in new bags of the type required by Rule 13 within 24 hours of inspection by and/or at the expense of the shipper;
- (c) the inspector may refuse to accept maize for grading if he is not satisfied that the shipper has made satisfactory arrangements for the expeditious re-bagging mentioned in paragraph (b) and the administration may levy charges for accommodation if such re-bagging is not completed within 24 hours (excluding Sunday and public holidays) from the time of refusal of acceptance by the inspector. The administration may, at its discretion, require the owner or shipper to remove any such maize not re-bagged within 24 hours of such refusal."

3. Rule 26 of the Principal Rules as published in the Gazette of 1925 is hereby renumbered as Rule 27.

RULES OF COURT MADE BY THE CHIEF JUSTICE  
UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE MOHAMMEDAN  
MARRIAGE DIVORCE AND SUCCESSION  
ORDINANCE.

(CHAPTER 171 REVISED LAWS OF KENYA):

1. These Rules may be cited as “Rules of Court (Mohammedan Marriage Divorce and Succession), No. 4 of 1926.”

2. A summons shall issue in all suits under the Mohammedan Marriage Divorce and Succession Ordinance.

3. Service shall be effected in the manner provided for the service of summonses by any law in force in the Colony relating to Civil Procedure.

4. The following fees shall be chargeable :—

(a) On a petition for dissolution of marriage or for restitution of conjugal rights, Sh. 30.

(b) For all other matters such Court fees as are in force in the Colony relating to Civil proceedings or to Probate and Administration proceedings as the case may be.

10. No building shall be erected on any plot unless plans, drawings, elevations and specifications thereof shall have been previously submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of Lands or such other person as he may appoint.

11. The grantee shall further submit a block plan of the plot with the position of the building clearly defined and showing a system of drainage, which shall satisfy the Town Clerk for the Township of Nairobi for properly dealing with the surface water on the plot and before any building may be occupied the grantee shall satisfy the said Town Clerk that such system of drainage has been properly constructed.

12. Each grantee shall suitably connect his premises with any town drainage system when, in the opinion of the said Town Clerk such drainage scheme is so far completed as to enable the grantee reasonably so to connect.

13. No building shall at any time during the term of the grant be used for any other purpose than a private dwelling house or used as a place of residence for natives who are not domestic servants in the employ of the grantee.

14. The grantee shall not at any time during the term of the grant assign any portion of a plot without the previous consent of the Governor in writing.

15. The grantee shall not at any time during the term of the grant erect any building or buildings so as to cover more than one-half of the area of the plot.

16. The Governor or such person as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon any plot and lay and have access to water mains and service pipes, telegraph or telephone wires, whether overhead or underground, and the grantees shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing routes, main or service pipes or the telegraph or telephone wires aforementioned.

17. Every purchaser shall bear the cost of deeds, Shs. 90, stamp duty, registration and survey fees and all other expenses, if any, connected with the purchase of the plot.
