LOCUST REPORT TO 5-11-29

FLYING SWARMS

Mature swarms to the north of the Colony have apparently been turned by the weather conditions prevailing there, and wireless reports indicate a steady and heavy southerly movement of mature locusts, particularly over Wajir and towards Archer's Post

These have been reported by scouts to the north of Meru, as also by one scout to the west of Meru

The direction of flight is southerly Voi, Malindi, Lamu and Moshi have been warned to expect swarms and laying Kitui and Machakos report that mature swarms have arrived

It is expected that the conditions obtaining one year ago namely, heavy laying in the Northern Frontier, Kitui, Tanaland, the easterly portion of Uganda, Voi, and possibly parts of Tanganyika, will again be repeated

There are no reports of mature or immature flying swarms from Kerio Province

Extensive laying is reported from Mount Kalama, near Mount Uluagess, and general laying in Merte, Baisalo, Archer's Post, Isiolo, Ngombe Crater, is anticipated

(Chapter 140, Revised Edition)

TENDERS FOR GRANT OF THEATRE AND CINEMA
PLOT, NAKURU TOWNSHIP

TENDERS are invited for a grant in respect of Plot No 1 of Section LVI, Nakuru Township, comprising 15,000 sq ft, for the purpose of erecting a Theatre or Cinema building, subject to the following conditions

1 The grantee of the plot will be required to erect on the plot within two years from the commencement of the grant a Theatre or Cinema building of approved design, constructed of stone, burnt brick or concrete, on proper foundations

2 Not more than 90% of the plot may be built over, provided that the area remaining unbuilt on shall be not less than 300 sq ft, and that the said area shall be free from any erection thereon above the level of the ground, except latrine accommodation constructed in accordance with all laws and by laws in force relating thereto and in accordance with the design approved by the Local Authority
