HIS Excellency the Governor has approved of the following Bill being introduced into the Legislative Council in substitution for the Bill published in the Official Gazette of the 11th February, 1930

**A Bill to Apply a Sum of Money for the Service of the Year ending the 31st day of December, 1930**

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

**1** This Ordinance may be cited as “ the Appropriation Ordinance, 1930 ” Short title

**2** The Public Revenue for the year 1930, and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya are hereby charged Public Revenue charged  
5 towards the services of the year ending the 31st day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, with a sum of three million five hundred and fifty-five thousand, five hundred and thirty-five pounds

**3** The money granted by this Ordinance shall be applied Application of money granted  
10 for the purposes and services expressed in the Schedule annexed hereto

**4** The Treasurer of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya is hereby authorised and required from time to time upon the warrant or order of the Governor to pay out of the Treasurer's authority for payment  
15 revenue and other funds of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, for the several services specified in the Schedule, the said sum of three million five hundred and fifty-five thousand, five hundred and thirty-five pounds, which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of  
20 December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty
