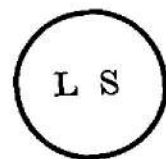

BY His Excellency Sir Henry Robert Moore Brooke-Popham, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Companion of the Distinguished Service Order, upon whom His Majesty has been pleased to confer the Air Force Cross, Air Chief Marshal in His Majesty's Royal Air Force, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by Clause XXX of the Instructions passed under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet to the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya and dated the 29th day of March, 1934, and all other powers thereunto enabling me, I hereby proclaim that the Legislative Council of the Colony shall be dissolved on the 10th day of February, 1938
