INDIAN AND ARAB SETTLEMENT BOARD

- (a) To report on the activities and economic position of the Indian farmers in those areas at present occupied by Indian agriculturalists.
- (b) To discover what demand exists among local Indians and Arabs for opportunities to take up an agricultural career, and particularly to ascertain the demand among locally born youths.
- (c) To suggest to the Government what land, in those areas of the Colony which are open to occupation by persons of all races, it considers to be suitable for Indian and Arab settlement, in order that the Government may appoint technical officers to examine and report on this land.
- (d) When the Government has received reports from its technical officers, and has made available a suitable area or areas for Indian and Arab settlement, to devise schemes, including financial recommendations, for the beneficial occupation of the land by Indian and Arab farmers.
- (e) To administer under the direction of the proposed Central Settlement Board such financial provisions as may be approved, and to arrange the training of prospective farmers.

A plan of the plots contained in the Schedule may be seen at the office of the Commissioner of Lands, Nairobi, or at the office of the District Commissioner, Kitale, as the case may be, or may be obtained on application to the Commissioner of Lands, P.O. Box 89, Nairobi, on payment of Sh. 3 each, post free.

The right to withdraw any plot from the sale is reserved to the Commissioner of Lands.

In the following conditions of sale the term Authority means the District Commissioner, Kitale, or such Municipal Authority as may be hereafter established by law.

Conditions of Sale of Option

1. The option in respect of each plot will be auctioned separately.

2. The amount of the advance of each bid will be regulated by the auctioneer and no bidding shall be retracted.

3. The highest bidder will be declared the purchaser of the option, but if any dispute arises as to any bid, the plot will be reoffered at the last undisputed bid.

14. The Government or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon any plot and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes, telegraph or telephone wires, and electric mains of all descriptions, whether overhead or underground, and the grantee shall not erect any building in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing routes, main or service pipes or the telegraph or telephone wires and electric mains aforementioned.

15. Grantees will be required to pay municipal rates upon the whole of the rateable interest and Government's contribution in lieu of rates assessed on the plots. A condition will, therefore, be embodied in each grant providing for the necessary adjustment between the grantee and Government.

16. Under Government Notice No. 20 of 1945 the permission of the Supply Board is required for the erection of a building exceeding £50 in value.
