#### VACANCY—CHIEF MALE MENTAL NURSE, MEDICAL DEPARTMENT

APPLICATIONS are invited for a post of Chief Male Mental Nurse in the Medical Department and should be submitted to the Secretary, European Civil Service Advisory Board, P.O. **A Bill to make Provision for the Proper Control of War Refugees and for their Expulsion in the Event of their Refusal or Neglect to Leave the Colony after Due Notice**

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the War Refugees (Control and Expulsion) Ordinance, 1946.

Interpretation.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires—

“camp” means any place appointed to be an evacuee camp for the purposes of the Defence (War Evacuees) Regulations, 1943, and any place appointed by the Director, under the provisions of paragraph (a) of section 4 of this Ordinance, to be a refugee camp; 5

“Camp Commandant” means the person appointed by the Director, under the provisions of paragraph (b) of section 4 of this Ordinance, to be in charge of any camp; 10

“Director” means any person appointed by the Governor to be the Director or an Assistant Director of War Refugees under the provisions of section 3 of this Ordinance;

“East Africa” means the Colony and Protectorate of Kenya, the Tanganyika Territory, Northern Rhodesia, the Nyasaland Protectorate, the Uganda Protectorate, the Belgian Congo and the Mandated Territory of Ruanda-Urundi; 15

“war refugee” means any person who has entered any part of East Africa during the war in pursuance of an arrangement made by any Government in East Africa for the reception of persons evacuated from war areas and is or has been permitted to enter the Colony without observance of the Immigration laws. 20

3. The Governor may, by notice published in the Gazette, appoint a Director of War Refugees and such other persons to be Assistant Directors of War Refugees as he may consider necessary for the proper carrying out of the provisions of this Ordinance. 25

4. The Director may, by notice published in the Gazette, appoint—  
(a) any place in the Colony to be a refugee camp for the purposes of this Ordinance; and 30  
(b) a suitable person to be a Camp Commandant in charge of any camp.

5. (1) It shall be lawful for the Director by order, in writing, to direct any war refugee, or any class of war refugees, to reside in such place in the Colony as may be specified in the order. 35

(2) Any order given under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section may contain such other supplementary or incidental provisions as the Director may deem necessary or expedient for the purpose of controlling the movements of any war refugee.

(3) Any war refugee who fails to comply with any order given to him under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section or with any provisions contained therein shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on conviction therefor, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month. 40

6. (1) A Camp Commandant of a camp may give such orders or directions, either orally or in writing, to any war refugee as he may deem necessary or expedient for any of the following purposes, that is to say— 45

(a) to ensure that the camp is administered in an orderly and efficient manner; 50

(b) to require any war refugee to perform any work or duty in connexion with the maintenance of essential services in the camp;

(c) to ensure that all proper precautions are taken to preserve the health and well-being of the war refugees in the camp; 55

(d) to preserve orderly conduct and discipline in the camp,

and may take such other measures as he may deem necessary or desirable for the general welfare of the war refugees in the camp.

(2) Any war refugee who fails to comply with any order or direction given to him under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on conviction therefor, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month:

Provided that a Camp Commandant may, in lieu of instituting any proceedings before a court for any such offence, investigate and hear the case summarily and if, after such investigation, he is satisfied beyond reasonable doubt that an offence has been committed he may—

(i) impose all or any of the following punishments—

- (a) reprimand;
- (b) suspension of any privilege;
- (c) extra camp duties;
- (d) suspension or reduction of any allowance or wage;
- (e) confinement to quarters or to the camp;

or

(ii) with the approval of the Director transfer the offender to another camp.

7. (1) Where any war refugee fails to comply with any order or direction given under the provisions of sections 5 or 6 of this Ordinance, and discipline in the camp is being, or is likely to be, prejudiced thereby, it shall be lawful for the Camp Commandant or, in his absence, the person for the time being in charge of the camp, or any police officer, to arrest, without warrant, such war refugee and to detain him in custody within the precincts of the camp in such building or in such part of the camp as may be set apart for that purpose.

Offender liable to arrest without warrant in certain cases.

(2) Any war refugee who is detained under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall, if not taken before a magistrate within twenty-four hours from the time of his arrest, be released from custody:

Provided that in computing the period of twenty-four hours there shall be excluded the period of a Sunday or public holiday.

8. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person other than a war refugee residing in, or a person employed in, a camp to enter or be within any camp except with the general or special permission of the Director or the Camp Commandant.

Control of entry into camps.

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, on conviction therefor, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month.

9. The Governor may by order, in writing, addressed to the Principal Immigration Officer or the Commissioner of Customs, as the case may be, exempt any war refugee or any class of war refugees, who are not within the Colony at the time of the coming into operation of this Ordinance, from any of the provisions of any law for the time being in force relating to immigration or customs duty.

War refugees entering the Colony may be exempted from any provisions of law relating to immigration or customs duty.

10. (1) Where any war refugee has received notice from the Director or the Camp Commandant of the camp in which he is residing that arrangements have been, or are being, made for his removal from the Colony at a time and by a vessel (or other means of conveyance) specified in such notice, and thereafter such war refugee refuses or neglects to leave the Colony at the time and in the manner specified in such notice, it shall be lawful for the Governor, by order under his hand, to direct that such war refugee shall be arrested and deported from the Colony in such manner as the Governor may direct.

Power to remove war refugees from the Colony.

(2) Any war refugee arrested under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall, pending his deportation from the Colony, be detained in custody in such manner and place as the Governor shall direct, and no such person shall be admitted to bail except with the consent of the Governor.

(3) Every order issued under the provisions of sub-section (1) of this section shall be deemed to authorize any police officer to arrest the person named in such order in any part of the Colony, to detain him in custody, and to place him on any vessel (or other means of conveyance) in which his removal from the Colony is to be effected.

(4) For the purposes of sub-section (1) of this section notice shall be deemed to be sufficient—

- (a) in the case of a war refugee residing in a camp, if the notice is signed by the Camp Commandant of such camp and is exhibited on the usual notice board therein, and it shall not

be necessary to specify in such notice the name of any individual affected thereby; and

(b) in the case of a war refugee who is not residing in a camp, if the notice is addressed to him by registered letter at his last known address. 5

(5) In this section the expression "war refugee" includes any person, other than a British subject and a person regarded, under the provisions of the British Protected Persons Order, 1934, as belonging to the Colony, who has been or is permitted to enter the Colony without observance of the immigration laws for the purpose of assisting in the 10 administration of any camp.

11. Every appointment made by the Director, or an Assistant Director, of Aliens and Internees and every order or direction given by them or by any Camp Commandant, under the provisions of the Defence (War Evacuees) Regulations, 1943, and in force on the 23rd 15 day of February, 1946, shall, notwithstanding the expiration of those Regulations, be revived and shall be deemed to have been made or given, under the provisions of this Ordinance, by the Director or a Camp Commandant, as the case may be.

#### MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

During the war a considerable number of refugees of various nationalities, who were evacuated from the combat areas of Europe, were received into the Colony, and a limited number of such persons are still being allowed entry from other East African territories. During the emergency in order to enable the necessary control to be exercised over such refugees the Defence (War Evacuees) Regulations, 1943, were enacted. Those Regulations expired on the 24th February, 1946, i.e. the date upon which the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts ceased to have effect, and it is considered necessary to re-enact their provisions so that a proper measure of control may continue to be exercised over those refugees whom it is not at present practicable to repatriate to Europe. Clauses 3 to 8 of the Bill seek to give effect to that decision.

The refugees were, and are, admitted to the Colony without being required to observe any of the formalities prescribed for immigrants by the legislation governing immigration. During the war such concessions were dictated by humanitarian considerations and by Military necessity and they are continuing to be granted, to a limited extent, in order to facilitate neighbouring territories. It has, however, always been an express or implied condition of the arrangement that such persons should not be permitted to remain in the Colony indefinitely, and that they should leave when opportunities occur for their removal to other suitable places. From time to time such opportunities will now occur, but there is reason to believe that a number of such persons will not voluntarily co-operate in the arrangements for their departure from the Colony. Such a failure to co-operate would cause serious embarrassment to the Government. Clause 10 of the Bill, therefore, seeks to enable the Governor to deport any war refugee who will not willingly leave the Colony although suitable arrangements have been made for his removal.

No expenditure of public moneys will be involved if the provisions of this Bill become law.

The Central Angling Advisory Board will not in fact be concerned with the economic aspect of fresh water fishing, which it will be the duty of the Game Department to foster. It is not proposed to transfer to the Board executive action in any direction, as such action must still remain with the Game Department, but the Board will have very considerable responsibility, in particular for the direction of trout conservation.

The members of the Board, other than the Fish Warden who is an *ex officio* member, will serve for a period of three years, at the end of which period two members will retire and thereafter two further members will retire annually by rotation.

One of the first duties of the Board will be to make recommendations to the Member for Agriculture regarding the establishment of Area Advisory Committees, as was recommended by the report of the Committee on the Control and Development of Fishing in Kenya (1938), as being in the best interests of the proper development of trout fishing. The personnel of these Committees will subsequently be published in the Official Gazette.
