A BILL ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS TARIFF ORDINANCE

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Tariff Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance Short title

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill will amend the Schedule to the Customs Tariff Ordinance (Chapter 262 of the 1948 Revised Edition) in the manner set out in *Clause 2* of the Bill

The object of the Bill is to lower the customs duty which is payable upon the items which are affected so as to assist in reducing the cost of living

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law, though some loss of revenue will result

A BILL ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EXCISE DUTIES ORDINANCE

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title	1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Excise Duties (Amendment) Ordinance, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Excise Duties Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

Amendment of Schedule to the principal Ordinance	2. The Schedule to the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting for the words and figures— “Tea, per lb 15” the words— “Tea, per lb Nil”

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill will amend the Schedule to the Excise Duties Ordinance (Chapter 265 of the 1948 Revised Edition) so as to provide that no excise duty will be payable on tea. The object of the legislation is to reduce the cost of living

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law, though there will be some loss of revenue
