IN ORDER to encourage the discovery and exploration of uran um deposits in Kenya, Uganda, Tanganyaka Swaziland and British Gurana, the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authorities announced in September 1957 that they were ready to buy annually in these territories chemical concentrates containing up to 100 tons of uranium oxide Contracts were to be offered covering a ten year period from coming into production of mine provided the end date of period did not extend beyond 1972. The prices offered were to be reasonable in the light of world conditions at the time having regard to the principle on which prices of uranium have been negotiated elsewhere

After two and a half years of search this offer has produced no response in any of the five territorics concerned. In the meantime there has been a decisive change in balance of supply and demand for manium and manium industries throughout the voild will be capable of producing far more manium than is required. There is no prospect of flew mines being required and if large quantities of manium were to be offered it can only be assumed that they would command in the light of world conditions at the time only minimal and unconomic prices.

In the light of this situation the United Kingdom Atomic Energy Authorities and Governments concerned have reviewed the position and as a result the Authority's offer to buy concentrate has been withdrawn

- 7 The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sums as the Commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid
