NEW ZEALAND AWARDS FOR 1961

As a result of the Educational Conference held in Oxford in 1959 Kenya is being offered New Zealand awards under the Commonwealth Scholarship and Fellowship Plan for entry into courses in New Zealand beginning in March, 1961

Awards will be made for a period of two academic years and the intervening summer but when a programme of studies so requires they may be made for a shorter or longer period

Each award will be continued for the period of study or research for which it is granted, provided that the student's progress and conduct are satisfactory

Each scholarship is intended to cover the expenses of travel living and study during its tenure.
