The above figures relate to reported incidents. The actual numbers may in the case of fatalities be 10 per cent higher. Non-fatal accidents and electrical fires caused by the electrical installation or equipment could be 50 per cent higher.

(2) UNAPPROVED ELECTRICAL MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT

It has come to the notice of the Ministry that there are various items of electrical equipment and accessories being sold and used in the country which do not comply with the provisions of the Electric Power Act (Cap 314)

Your attention is therefore drawn to section 51 and the rules made under section 145 of the above Act. The section and rules carry penalties.

Among the accessories, cables and equipment which do not comply with the above Act, and are potentially dangerous, are —

- (1) Certain non-metallic conduit and accessories
- (2) Certain switch socket outlets including those with the flag trade mark
- (3) Certain tumbler switches
- (4) Low-grade metallic conduit
- (5) Certain multiple socket outlet adaptors and especially those with crossed Polarity
- (6) Adaptors converting three pins to two pins socket outlets
- (7) Certain hair drier and hair straighteners
- (8) Three phase (415V) portable tools
- (9) Certain instantaneous Water Heaters
- (10) Auto-transformers intended for use in conjunction with portable equipment of any type
- (11) Any appliances, equipment, lamps and associated accessories rated at a voltage other than 240V
- (12) Certain shaver units
- (13) Metallic table or floor standings lamps with two core flexible leads
- (14) Cables having colour coding other than —
Red or Brown for live or phase or positive wire
Black or Blue for neutral or negative wire
Green/Yellow for earthing wire

You are hereby reminded that you are required to ensure that you neither use nor deal in any of the afore mentioned accessories, cables and equipment.

The fore-mentioned list is not necessarily a complete one and items mentioned will bear no markings of specifications.

If you are in any doubt as to the compliance with the above Act, of any accessories, cables and equipment you should verify whether approval has been given by the Government Electrical Inspector.

(3) EXTENDED USE OF EARTH LEAKAGE CIRCUIT BREAKERS

It is intended to introduce an amendment to the Electrical Power Act (Cap 314), making the use of Core Balance Earth Leakage Circuit Breaker compulsory on medium voltage (110V-650V) electrical installations. This will mainly effect socket outlets in industrial applications and domestic installations.

Issue in dispute —

Termination of employment of Mr E S Achalla under rule 25 (b) of the Terms and Conditions of Service for employees in Salaried Grades

1 The Kenya Local Government Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Nairobi City Council shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on 11th October, 1972, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 Mr Achalla started working for the Respondents in December, 1963, and was subsequently promoted to the post of Accountant Grade IV in charge of the Council's Petty Cash Imprest

On 8th February, 1970, a report was made to the Kenya Police in respect of certain shortages in respect of funds under the control of Mr Achalla and the Police started its inquiries

On 10th February, 1970, the Staff Committee of the Respondents took the decision to terminate Mr Achalla's services. The Staff Committee resolved —

"To recommend to the Finance Committee that in view of the City Treasurer's report authority be given to pay Mr E S Achalla, Accountant IV, three months' salary in lieu of notice to terminate his services with Council forthwith"

On 13th February, 1970, the Town Clerk wrote to Mr Achalla as follows —

"I write to inform you that the Staff Committee at its meeting held on 10th February, 1970, decided that your services be terminated, which I hereby do, by payment of three months' salary in lieu of notice"

This matter then went through the various Committee stages and came up at the monthly meeting of the full Council on 7th July, 1970. The Council resolution on this particular matter was that it should be referred back to the Finance Committee for further consideration

The Finance Committee however, at its next meeting on 16th September, 1970, confirmed its earlier decision that Mr Achalla should not be reinstated

The Claimants who had all along been actively making representations on his behalf at Joint Staff Committee, were not satisfied with the Finance Committee's decision and reported the existence of a trade dispute to the Ministry of Labour on 5th December, 1970

An Investigator was appointed by the Ministry of Labour and his findings and recommendations were as follows —

"(i) Mr Achalla was reported to the Police on suspicion of having misappropriated the Council's funds

- (ii) The Police prosecuted Mr Achalla but the Court acquitted him
- (iii) His services were terminated before the Court proceedings were over
- (iv) The Council erred by terminating Mr Achalla's services before the decision of the Court was known

In view of the above findings I recommend that the Council should consider reinstating Mr Achalla. The Council will decide in which Department Mr Achalla will be placed."

The Claimants naturally accepted these recommendations but the Respondents rejected them. For some unknown reason the matter had dragged on until 5th January, 1972, when the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Labour, published the findings of the Investigator.

The parties then signed the Notification of Dispute Form "A" which was forwarded to the Industrial Court on 5th August, 1972, accompanied by the necessary certificates from the Labour Commissioner and the Minister for Labour dated 27th July, 1972.

The Court notes that Mr Achalla was charged in the Resident Magistrate's Court on 13th February, 1970, with the offence of stealing by clerk contra section 281 of the Penal Code. He was also charged with the offence of fraudulent false accounting and faced four counts in respect thereof.

On 8th April, 1970, he was acquitted of all the charges by the Resident Magistrate, Nairobi.

The Claimants' submission is that Mr Achalla's termination is wrongful under clause 25 of the Terms and Conditions of Service applicable because since he had been involved in criminal proceedings he should have been suspended in the first place under clause 27 (b) and on his acquittal the suspension should have been lifted as he then could not be dismissed under 27 (c).

The Claimants maintained that the City Treasurer had brought about Mr Achalla's termination for reasons best known to him rather than waiting for the outcome of the criminal proceedings.

The Respondents strongly submitted that in clause 27 the Head of the Department had been given discretionary powers because the word "may" has been used in subsection (a). Therefore it was quite in order for the Respondents not to suspend Mr Achalla under 27 (b) and to terminate his services under clause 25.

The Respondents stated that the reason for terminating Mr Achalla's services was because he had committed a gross breach of the written instructions which officers handling cash are required to sign. They added that Mr Achalla had signed these instructions.

The Court has carefully considered the various submissions and in the absence of clear evidence as to what report the City Treasurer made at the Staff Committee meeting of 10th February, 1972, the Court must find the real reason for terminating the services of Mr Achalla was the impending criminal proceedings against him which in fact started against him on 13th February, 1970, the day his services were officially terminated by the Town Clerk.

Further the Investigator has recorded that the Respondents had submitted to him —

"Mr Achalla was not dismissed but his services were terminated in accordance with the Terms and Conditions of Service for employees in the salaried grades covering the employees of the City Council of Nairobi. The relevant clause in this case is 25 (b) which provides for the payment of three months salary by either party in lieu of notice to terminate services. The Council adhered to the provisions of the clause hence no dispute existed between them and the Union."

Keeping all these points in view the Court finds that if what the Respondents allege was the true reason for terminating the services of Mr Achalla, then action should have been taken against him under clause 26 dealing with "discipline".

For the foregoing reasons the Court finds that the services of Mr Achalla were terminated wrongfully by the Respondents.

Now coming to the question of whether or not Mr Achalla should be reinstated in his former employment. The Court has given anxious thought to this matter and has come to the conclusion that an award of compensation for wrongful termination of his services would be appropriate under the circumstances.

The Court therefore awards that Mr Achalla should be paid six months' additional salary by way of compensation for his wrongful dismissal.

THAT, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Council by section 8 of the said Act, the following works be carried out in the roads hereinbefore referred to, that is to say, to level, kerb, metal, drain and construct the carriageways and install street lighting in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer and the expenses incurred by the Council in executing the said works be apportioned among the lands fronting, adjoining, abutting or served by the said streets, according to the respective frontages thereto and recovered from the owners of such lands
