Nomination papers for the presidential election may be delivered by the candidate or his proposer or seconder to the Supervisor of Elections, Office of the Attorney-General, Nairobi, between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and noon on the 16th day of October, 1979.

THE PARLIAMENTARY AND PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS REGULATIONS

(Cap. 7, Sub. Leg.)

NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

ELECTIONS are to be held of members to serve in the National Assembly for all constituencies.

Preliminary elections will be held on the 8th day of November, 1979.

A nomination paper for the preliminary elections may be delivered by the candidate to the returning officer at his office in the office of the District Commissioner in the district in which the constituency is situated (or, in the case of constituencies in the Nairobi Area, in the office of the Provincial Commissioner of the Nairobi Area) between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and noon on the 18th day of October, 1979.

The day of nomination, of persons selected at the preliminary elections, will be the 22nd day of November, 1979, and such nomination shall be effected at the office of the returning officer aforesaid.

If the parliamentary election is contested, the poll will take place on the 6th day of December, 1979.

NOTES

The attention of candidates and persons subscribing nomination papers is drawn to the rules for filling up nomination papers and other provisions relating to nominations contained in the Parliamentary and Presidential Elections Regulations.

2. A person guilty of an election offence will be liable to the penalties imposed by the Election Offences Act, and to the disqualifications imposed by the National Assembly and Presidential Elections Act.
