- Burial expenses.
- Gratuity.
- Working hours.
- Calculation of overtime payment rate.

1. The Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Pan Africa Insurance Co. Ltd., shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties appeared before the Court on 20th April, 1979 when the hearing was fixed for 11th June. On 11th June the Claimants informed the Court that they had not been able to prepare their written submission and asked for another three weeks. The hearing was then fixed for 30th July on which date the Claimants again asked for the dispute to be adjourned. The parties were then called for mention on 14th August and the hearing was fixed for 29th August, 1979.

The parties were heard on 29th August and 14th and 26th September, 1979 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

## AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 9th January, 1979 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 5th April together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The previous collective agreement between the parties was effective from 1st January, 1977 and expired on 31st December, 1978. The parties have agreed that the new collective agreement

is to be effective from 1st January, 1979 and that it should remain in force for a period of two years from that date.

This dispute was bitterly contested on all the issues. The Claimants' main submissions can be summed up as follows.

They have accused the Respondents of giving preferential treatment, out of all proportion, to their managerial staff numbering about 26. In fact they went as far as to say that these 26 managerial staff received every month almost the same remuneration which the Claimants' 116 members working in the life department at Mombasa received.

They also produced documents to indicate in their opinion the unjustified expenditure in respect of members of top management in the Respondents' undertaking.

The other point which the Claimants made very vigorously during the hearing was that all the Respondents' employees in the general assurance department were enjoying better terms and conditions of employment than the employees in the life department. The Claimants pointed out that they had no members in the general assurance department which was comparatively a new section. They referred to a lunch voucher scheme which was in operation in respect of these employees but the Respondents clarified this point by saying that such a scheme had been introduced on an experimental basis and was now going to be withdrawn.

The Respondents on the other hand very vigorously submitted that their employees were enjoying better salaries and benefits than the employees of the member companies of the Insurance Employers Group of F.K.E. They added that they had expressed a desire to join this Group but the Claimants had opposed such a move.

The Respondents admitted that they had not made any offer to the Claimants on wages either at the parties' own meetings or during conciliation. They added, however, that the reason why they did so was because through an administrative error they had been and are still overpaying some of their employees by a total of K.Sh. 17,980 p.m.

The Respondents pleaded with the Court to defer the implementation of the award on the issue of wages until the dispute between the parties on this matter of overpayment had been settled as it was in the pipeline and would be coming to the Court in the near future. As was to be expected this point led to a lot of heated arguments between the parties with the name of a former member of management figuring prominently in connexion therewith. The Court, however, has no intention at all to apply its mind to this matter as it will in due course come before it as a separate dispute in case it is not settled.

Another item which again generated a lot of heated argument was the Claimants' allegation that an agreement which they had arrived at in the presence of a Conciliator had been altered without their knowledge by the Respondents and the Federation of Kenya Employers and the Conciliator. The alleged alteration was the change of the words "years of service" to "salary scale". This item again does not merit any comment from the Court in this dispute.

The Claimants asked the Court to grant them the maximum permissible increases under the Guidelines and to bear in mind that the Respondents give annual bonuses to some of their employees from the huge profits which they make every year. Their members were denied this bonus.

The Claimants stated that the current annual incremental rates were as follows:

The Claimants demanded the following wage increases and annual incremental rates:

50 per cent wage increase.

10 per cent of new entry point becomes the annual incremental rate.

Special subordinate:

As above.

Clerical II:

40 per cent increase.

10 per cent of new entry point becomes the annual incremental rate.

Clerical I:

As Clerical II.

Senior Clerical:

30 per cent wage increase.

10 per cent of new entry point becomes the annual incremental rate."

The Respondents argued that the wages should be adjusted within the present Guidelines and by the fixed grade figures as follows:

The Employment Promotion Division have confirmed that the Nairobi wage earners cost of living indices had risen as follows during the life of the previous agreement (1977/78):

Lower income group .. .. . 37.2 per cent

Middle income group .. .. . 22.7 per cent

Upper income group .. .. . 21.9 per cent

The E.P.D. have further pointed out that as against the Claimants' demand of 40 per cent and the Respondents' offer of 8.2 per cent the maximum permissible increase under the Guidelines with 1977 GDP included averaged at 17.5 per cent.

The Court notes that in line with the past practice between the parties, the parties are agreed that the general wage increase should be granted to the workers at the commencement of the new collective agreement instead of being split in two instalments. The reason for this is that the latter period of the agreement is taken care of by the annual increments.

After careful consideration of all the submissions and taking into account the present Guidelines the Court awards the following rates for various grades provided that;

(a) For the purposes of this award the years of service shall be counted as from the date of the first collective agreement concluded between the parties on 4th November, 1968.

(b) For the employees whose basic monthly wages are below the specified new minimum rates for their grades, their wages shall be brought up to the applicable new minimum rates for their grades and then be granted wage increases for such grades.

(c) The employees earning over and above their grade rates shall be granted increases not less favourable than the increase awarded to their grades.

(d) Where an employee's basic monthly salary falls between two points within the grade the salary of such employee shall be brought to next salary rate within such grade.

Annual increments for all grades to remain as per the current agreement.

The Court finds that the Respondents have raised a very valid point in respect of these items in that the recognition agreement does not allow negotiations on them. Clause 2 (a) of the recognition agreement reads as follows:

"2 (a) The company affords full recognition to the union as a properly constituted and representative body and the sole labour organization representing the interests of workers who are in the employment of the company concerning rates of pay and overtime, hours of work, method of wage payment, paid leave, duration of employment, collection of union dues, retirement benefits, medical benefits, and principles of redundancy. This shall not include supervisory staff as defined from time to time by the FKE and COTU (K)."

In view of the quite clear wording of this clause the Court cannot help the Claimants at all on these items until such time as the recognition agreement is amended.

## Gratuity

The Court rejects the Claimants' demand on this item.

## Working hours

The Claimants indicated that there was no dispute on this item.

## Calculation of overtime payment rate

The Court awards that the formula for the purpose of establishing the rate should be:

$$\text{Normal hourly rate} = \frac{\text{basic monthly wage}}{158 \text{ hours p.m.}}$$

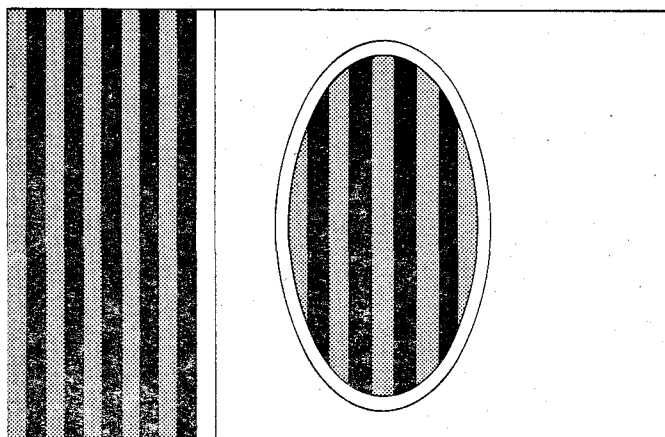

D.41. (1) Communications for the *Kenya Gazette* should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the *Gazette*.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward *Gazette* notices to the Government Printer when ready.

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.
