**ORDER**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Rabies Act, the Director of Veterinary Services hereby orders that the following provisions shall have effect and be complied with in the area specified in the Schedule hereto, which is an area in which rabies has broken out:—

1. For a period of three months from the coming into operation of this order, or for such longer period as the Director of Veterinary Services shall by notice declare, all dogs shall at all times be secured on leads except when in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building and shall be kept in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

2. After the expiration of three months or such longer period as aforesaid, all dogs shall be secured on leads at all times when on or near a public road and shall be kept in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.

3. (1) Any dog that is suspected of having been bitten by or been in contact with a rabid animal may, if not destroyed, with the approval of a veterinary officer be secured in a place of isolation as hereinafter provided and kept under observation for a period of at least six months and shall be examined at least once a month by a veterinary officer during such period.

(2) A dog is deemed to have been in contact with an animal if it has been in the same building, kennel, field or other place as the animal.

4. For the purposes of paragraph 3, the dog shall be secured in a suitable place of detention in the immediate neighbourhood of the place where the dog is normally kept or in such other place as may be approved by the Director of Veterinary Services.

5. The place of detention shall comprise a kennel or other enclosure with sufficient adjoining space to provide for the full liberty of the dog in the open air, the whole being so enclosed as to prevent the escape of the dog therefrom or its contact with any other dog:

Provided that in the absence of such facilities the dog may, as a temporary expedient, be detained in such manner as may be approved by a veterinary officer or inspector.

6. A veterinary officer, or any person authorized by him in writing, may destroy any dog not controlled in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3, 4 and 5.

7. The carcass of an animal that has died from rabies or that has been destroyed on account of rabies shall be burned or buried by the owner or the person in charge of such animal.

8. No person shall move any dog or cause any dog to be moved out of or into the area specified in the Schedule without the prior written permission of a veterinary officer.

## THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE NO. 52 OF 1979

## Parties:—

Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers  
and

Firestone East Africa (1969) Ltd.

*Issue in dispute.*—Termination of services of Gabriel Anzu.

1. The Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Firestone East Africa (1969) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 5th day of October, 1979, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath:—

*Claimants.*—Gabriel Anzu.

*Respondents.*—M. M. Rodrigues and C. Wafula.

## AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 5th March, 1979, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 7th August together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Gabriel Anzu was employed by the Respondents as a packer on 1st July, 1976, and during his service he was also gaining experience to handle the duties of the storekeeper as and when the need arose.

On 10th May, 1978, the storekeeper, H. Karani, was sick because the Court was told, he had been beaten up by some thugs. He was given 15 days' off duty. The Depot Manager called upon Mr. Anzu to take over the storekeeper's job until he reported back on duty.

During the time Mr. Anzu was in charge of the store, when work resumed on Monday, 22nd May, 1978, it was discovered that 36 tyres and 64 tubes worth Sh. 57,736 had been stolen. Since there was no evidence of a break-in the Respondents' security people came to the conclusion that it was an inside job. The matter was reported to the police but nobody was prosecuted.

On 22nd June, 1978, Mr. Anzu's services were terminated. The Respondents stated in the letter of termination that although there had been no proof as to how the tyres left the warehouse the fact remained that he was in possession of the key to the warehouse and the management could no longer trust him in any position within the organization. He was offered pay up to 22nd June, 21 days' leave and one month's salary in lieu of notice.

The Claimants having taken up the matter on his behalf the matter was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and on 23rd January, 1979, the Ministry's findings and recommendations were conveyed to the parties to form the basis of the settlement of the dispute:

*"Findings:*

Prior to the incident of the theft of tyres and tubes worth Sh. 57,736 Mr. Anzu had not received any warning and therefore he must have been a good worker. When Mr. Anzu discovered the shortage he reported the matter to the management as proved by the fact that a stock sheet was prepared and signed by him for that day. The mere fact that no theft had occurred when the other two employees held the keys or that he started living beyond his means or that when his brother worked on similar position a theft occurred does not prove that Mr. Anzu stole the tyres and tubes that week-end.

Even the management are not sure as they submitted that they felt the three men must have colluded with the security men.

It is therefore my considered opinion that the termination was not justified.

*Recommendation:*

It is therefore recommended that Mr. Anzu should be paid three months' wages as compensation and in addition all his terminal benefits."

The Respondents' witness, Mr. Rodrigues, who was the Nairobi Depot Manager, gave evidence during the hearing. He stated that on the evening of 22nd May he passed through the warehouse to go to the toilet. In the warehouse he found all the tyres scattered all over which was most unusual. On seeing that he asked Mr. Anzu to make a stock list and to give it to

him as soon as possible. Mr. Anzu did not do so and Mr. Rodrigues then instructed Mr. Kagiri, the ledger clerk, to take physical stock and to check it with the ledgers. As he had to attend a client he left and came back at 11.30 a.m. Mr. Kagiri met him and told him that some tyres were missing. He called Mr. Anzu and asked him about the missing tyres and tubes and Mr. Anzu said, "I don't know anything about it". Mr. Rodrigues said that he offered to help him but he still said that he did not know anything. Mr. Rodrigues was emphatic that it was Mr. Kagiri who detected the theft and came and told him about it and not Mr. Anzu.

Mr. Anzu, however, in his evidence, stated that he prepared the opening stock sheet on 22nd May and it was he who detected the loss after which he went to the ledger clerk for checking. He maintained that he then went to the Depot Manager at 9.30 to present his report. Mr. Anzu also admitted that he had all the keys in his possession with the other set of the keys being in the head office at Mombasa Road.

Mr. A. C. Wafula, the Respondents' security officer, while giving evidence stated that when he was informed of the theft he went to the depot and asked for the inventories and was given an inventory by the Depot Manager which had been prepared by Mr. Kagiri. He stated that this was a comprehensive inventory. He also added that Mr. Karani reported for duty on that Monday. He also added that Mr. Kagiri had taken the stock and Mr. Karani had helped in preparing the inventory.

The Court is satisfied that the storekeeper was not required to prepare a stock inventory at the end of the day but had to prepare one in the morning of the following day before the commencement of the business. The Respondents' written submission on this point is not borne out by the evidence of their witness, Mr. Rodrigues.

Both the parties are agreed that it was an inside job with the Claimants maintaining that Mr. Anzu had no hand in this theft and asked for him to be reinstated without loss of any salary and benefits.

The Court can visualize the position in which the Respondents found themselves in that the only person during that week-end who officially had the key to the warehouse was Mr. Anzu although the other possibilities are also there: that Mr. Karani, the substantive storekeeper could have made a duplicate key and that Mr. Kagiri had also possessed the key on one occasion about a year ago so he could also have made a duplicate key. Apart from this aspect of the possession of the key to the warehouse it is quite obvious that the security guards who guarded the premises during that week-end could also have had a hand in this theft because the removal of 36 trailer tyres and 64 tubes is not a small operation.

One fact in favour of Mr. Anzu is that although he was detained by the police for a couple of days he was released and was not charged with any criminal offence and it appears that sometime during that day he had prepared a stock sheet which he had signed and which the Ministry of Labour Investigator saw. The Court doubts if he gave it to Mr. Rodrigues.

The Court has carefully considered the various aspects of this dispute and the evidence that was given by all the witnesses and has come to the conclusion that the Court is not in a position to find one way or the other the extent of involvement, if any, of Mr. Anzu in this theft but because he was the person in charge of the warehouse during that time and had in his possession all the keys the Court has come to the conclusion that that fact in itself entitles them to lose confidence in him in any position in their undertaking. The other possibilities are too remote.

The Respondents have, however, indicated to the Ministry of Labour that they were prepared to abide by the Ministry's recommendations and pay three months' wages as compensation to Mr. Anzu.

The Court finds that it cannot order Mr. Anzu's unconditional reinstatement without loss of any salary or benefits but in view of the Respondents' acceptance of the Ministry's recommendations the Court awards that in addition to what the Respondents had offered to pay Mr. Anzu in his letter of dismissal they should pay him another three months' wages by way of compensation as recommended by the Ministry of Labour.
