AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 9th November, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 22nd March, 1983, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Joseph Muchela worked for the respondents from 1st September, 1970, until 12th November, 1981, when his services were terminated. He was offered the following dues:

Three months' pay including house allowance in lieu of notice.

Salary plus housing allowance up to and including 13th November, 1981.

Twenty-three days being accrued leave entitlement.

Gratuity at half-monthly salary for eleven years.

His own and company contribution towards the staff provident fund.

At the time of termination he was a sales representative covering an area including Emali, Amboseli, Loitokitok and all the markets on the route in Tsavo park.

The allegation against him was that he had altered a cash sale No. E. 129457 for its date to read 23rd August instead of 22nd August as it should have been. The court finds it proved that on 22nd August, 1981, Mr. Muchela bought 60½ litres of petrol from Emali service station out of which 30 were put in the car which the company had provided him for his duties (No. KPP 219) and the remaining petrol was put in a jerrycan. It is also established that two separate cash sales were issued—E. 129456 and E. 129457—and the duplicates of these cash sales at the Emali Service Station showed the date on both of them being 22nd August, 1981, whereas on the receipts accompanying a claim for refund put in by Mr. Muchela cash sale No. E. 129457 had an alteration in the date reading 23rd August. He denied having made this alteration.

The claimants having reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour the dispute was investigated by the ministry whose findings was that Mr. Muchela had suffered a wrongful dismissal and he should be reinstated to his job without loss of benefits and be paid salary for the period he had been out of employment. The respondents rejected the finding.

Mr. Muchela while giving evidence during the hearing stated that on the day in question, i.e. 22nd August, he had filled his car and because some motorists coming from Loitokitok told him that there was no fuel there he decided to get extra fuel to be able to complete the round trip to Loitokitok. He said previously also he had done the same. He gave details of the route and the places he had visited on the day in question

and stated that he had undertaken a special exercise in connection with the introduction of the new system relating to "flats" which had necessitated him not sticking to his original itinerary.

The respondents strongly submitted that the investigations carried out by them had left them in no doubt whatsoever that the 30½ litres of petrol claimed by Mr. Muchela had not been used for company business and that he had altered cash sale E. 129457 to read 23rd August in order to cheat them as to the date he purchased 30½ litres in a jerrycan. This he did after realizing that he might be questioned as to why he took so much petrol in one day.

The court has applied its mind to the claimants' submission on which they have based their claim primarily that Mr. Muchela had not altered this receipt and that there was some sort of conspiracy between the marketing manager and the respondents' investigating officers to get Mr. Muchela dismissed. This, however, remains a mere allegation because apart from the claimants' assertion to this effect there was absolutely no evidence to prove it. But then the question remains why Mr. Muchela's immediate superior who had signed and forwarded his claims for the month of August, 1981, to which were attached all the cash sale receipts did not spot this alteration and raise the necessary query? Why was it left to a very senior officer of the respondents, Mr. Correa, to detect this particular point which resulted in the investigations that led to Mr. Muchela's dismissal? This is the only point in favour of Mr. Muchela in this dispute as his other explanations regarding checking and stopping at the various bars and restaurants on the circuitous route within the game parks appear to have been an afterthought as all along he had maintained that his trip was from Emali to Loitokitok and back. He has thought of this no doubt to justify the purchase of extra petrol in the jerrycan. A letter from the Automobile Association shows that the distance which Mr. Muchela claims to have covered at the material time is 430 km. and that 90 per cent of the distance from this mileage is within the national parks where the speed limit is 25 kph. Going on this premise the total distance would be covered within the duration of fourteen hours which would make it more or less impossible for Mr. Muchela to complete the journey in one day without having a night stop.

The court, however, cannot overlook another point and that is Mr. Muchela's claim was not rejected by the computer which the court was told was programmed in such a manner that if there was any irregularity then the claim would be rejected. So the distance covered by Mr. Muchela in August and the petrol consumed by him was within the laid down limits.

The court has noted that the two investigators appointed by the respondents went only up to Emali during this investigation and do not appear to have gone beyond Emali to the various other markets on the circuitous route up to Loitokitok. They confined themselves only to checking that the duplicates of E. 129456 and 7 had no alteration.

It is not disputed that Mr. Muchela was not paid the amount which he spent on E. 129457 amounting to KSh. 205.

The court having made the above findings and having highlighted the respective points in favour of the claimants and the respondents finds that the dispute is very evenly poised as no one other than Mr. Muchela had an interest in altering the receipt and yet the question remains if he had altered the receipt when he made the claim why was it not detected by his immediate superior who signed his claim form and forward it to the head office? The court finds that the scales tip in favour of Mr. Muchela but only just, and although this would entitle him to be given the benefit of doubt and a finding by the court that he has suffered a wrongful termination it would not entitle him to a reinstatement or full compensation as provided under the Trade Dispute Act. The court notes that he has already been offered three months' pay including house allowance in lieu of notice in addition to his other benefits as specified in his letter of termination. In addition to this the court awards that the respondents should pay him an additional four months' salary without house allowance for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered.
