2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 21st March, 1984, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses:

- S. Ochieng.

Respondents.-L. Mbatti.

Award

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 3rd December, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 3rd June, 1983, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The two grievants in this dispute worked for the respondents s follows:

- S. Ochieng.—11th October, 1964, to 15th August, 1981.
- S. Omondi.—Worked for the respondents previously for five years when he was declared redundant and was reemployed in March, 1972, and worked for them until 7th August, 1981.

Both of them were dismissed for alleged conspiracy to defraud and obtaining money by false pretences. Both of them were

prosecuted in the criminal court and were subsequently acquitted on 2nd and 25th January, 1982. They were, however, dismissed when they reported for work on 12th August, 1981, when they were told to go home and come back on 15th when they were served with dismissal letters.

The dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour whose report was released on 16th November, 1982, in which the finding was that the two employees were charged in a court of law on grounds that they had claimed and had been paid money for overtime which they had not actually worked and the management had failed to produce any evidence on the offences alleged to have been committed. It recommended that they be paid their terminal benefits plus three months' salary each as compensation for wrongful dismissal.

The respondents have alleged that Mr. Omondi had falsely claimed and was paid KSh. 221.45 as overtime which he had not actually worked and Mr. Ochieng was paid KSh. 32.95 which he had falsely claimed to have worked as overtime.

During the hearing the claimants alleged that the respondents had taken a hasty decision in dismissing them as both the grievants had been handed over to the police to be charged in the criminal court. They felt that the respondents should have waited for the outcome of the criminal proceedings. As it turned out both of them were acquitted in the criminal court with Mr. Ochieng having no case to answer at the end of the trial.

The respondents stated that both the grievants with four other colleagues were arrested and charged with the offence of conspiring to defraud the respondents. Four others were found guilty of charges of conspiracy but the two grievants were acquitted by the court. The respondents maintained that their acquittal did not clear them on the charge of obtaining money by fraudulent pretences had they been charged of that offence. In any case they submitted that they had reasonable and sufficient grounds for suspecting the two persons of having committed a criminal offence.

The court heard the evidence given by the two grievants and the respondents' witness and the court is satisfied that the respondents may have suspected these two employees of having claimed overtime when they had not worked but the fact remains that it is highly unlikely that they could have got away with these false claims if they had not been part and parcel of a big conspiracy involving some senior employees in the company. The fact that the respondents' records got lost at the police station and the respondents' witness conceeding in cross-examination that something is missing somewhere does not help the respondents' case. In these circumstances the acquittal of the two grievants in the criminal case when four of their colleagues were convicted plays an important part in this dispute. The court finds itself in agreement with the ministry's findings that they have suffered a wrongful dismissal. However, the court is of the view that they do not deserve reinstatement and awards that Mr. Ochieng be paid six months' salary by way of compensation for two wrongful dismissal that he has suffered in addition to his terminal benefits and Mr. Omondi should be paid three months' salary by way of compensation again in addition to his terminal benefits.

Dismissal of Aggrey Apolo and Jairus Namunyu.

THE Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Sembi Motors Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were invited to a mention on 23rd August, 1983, for finalizing the arrangements for the mention and for fixing a hearing date. The respondents failed to appear. The court ordered the claimants to submit their memorandum on

22nd September, 1983, and the respondents were ordered to submit theirs on 24th October, 1983. The hearing was fixed for 3rd November, 1983.

The claimants submitted their memo as ordered and appeared in court for hearing on 3rd November. The respondents, however, did not file their replying memo and again failed to appear in court. The court decided to give them one more chance and invited the parties to a further mention on 9th January, 1984, when the respondents again failed to attend and the court fixed the hearing for 10th April. The respondents were duly informed of the hearing date.

On 10th April the respondents again failed to attend and the court then decided to proceed with the hearing expart.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 30th May, 1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 7th July that year together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The two grievants, Messrs. Apolo and Namunyu, started working for the respondents on 6th January, 1965 and August, 1975, respectively. They were summarily dismissed on 21st April, 1981, when each one of them was earning a monthly wage of KSh. 1,200.

The allegation against them which led to their summary dismissal was that they were seen repairing a vehicle outside their place of work on 17th April, 1981. The respondents had alleged that they had persuaded a customer to remove a vehicle from the workshop so that they could repair it privately out of the official business. The claimants denied this allegation insisting that neither the management nor their agents saw them working on that vehicle. The claimants alleged that this was confirmed by the owner of the vehicle who stated that he never made any private deal with these workers and that his vehicle had been repaired at Kakamega Vehicle Body Repairs where charges quoted to him were lower than the respondents'.

Unfortunately for the respondents they failed to either submit a memo or appear in person in court and the court is left only with the claimants' written and verbal submissions. The claimants have submitted that their members suffered a wrongful dismissal as the respondents violated the procedure laid down in the existing collective agreement in dismissing them and demanded that they be reinstated to their jobs unconditionally and the respondents should be ordered to pay them salary for all the time they had been out of employment.

The court has decided in this dispute to rely on the findings and recommendation of the Ministry of Labour which were in favour of the claimants in that the grievants had suffered a wrongful dismissal because on 17th April, 1981, the day the respondents claimed they found them working on the said vehicle privately was a public holiday, i.e. Good Friday. The investigator rejected the accounts given by the respondents' watchman and the managing director. The ministry recommended that the summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination and they should be paid their terminal benefits in accordance with the parties' collective agreement and in addition to respondents should pay them three months' wages for dismissing them wrongfully.

The court finds the ministry's recommendation to be reasonable under the circumstances and the court awards that the respondents should pay the two grievants their dues and compensation as recommended by the ministry as stated hereinabove.

3. The Court awards that the respondents should pay a further sum of KSh. 4,960 to Mrs. Deya in addition to KSh. 7,855 which they have already paid her provided that tax deduction would be verified and if necessary any adjustments will be made with the assistance of the Chief Industrial Relations

The claimants' other demands are beyond the scope of this dispute and they should seek their redress on Mrs. Deva's statutory entitlements through the provincial labour officer and the Labour Commissioner. The court would like to record that the cheque for KSh. 4,960 was handed over to the claimants by the respondents.



THE TRUST LAND ACT (Cap. 288)

KAPSABET TOWNSHIP-PLOTS FOR ALIENATION

THE Commissioner of Lands invites applications for alienation of plots in the above-mentioned area described in the schedule hereto. A plan of the plots may be seen in the Public Map Office, Lands building, city square, Nairobi, or obtained therefrom on payment of KSh. 10.

- (c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to pay within thirty (30) days of the offer of a plot from the date of the letter of allotment, and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.
- 4. Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating:
 - (a) The amount of capital available for the purchase of the plot.
 - (b) The amount of capital available for the development of the plot. Attach a bank statement or letter from a bank or any other financial institution indicating the amount of development loan they are prepared to give you if you are allocated with a plot.

General Conditions

- 1. The grant will be prepared under the provision of the Government Lands Act (Cap. 280), and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap. 281).
- 2. The grant will be made in the name(s) of the allottee(s) as given in the letter of application and will be subject to special conditions set out below.
- 3. The term of the grant will be for ninety-nine (99) years from the first day of the month following the issue of letter of allotment.

Special Conditions

- 1. No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plan and specifications previously approved in writing by the local authority. The local authority shall not give approval unless it is satisfied that the proposals are as such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.
- 2. - 3. The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the grantee give notice in writing to the county council that she/he/they/is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the county council shall (at the grantee's expenses) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given within twelve (12) months of the commencement of the term the county council shall refund to the grantee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the county council shall refund to the grantee five per cent of the said stand premium. All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of an A4 sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.
