### VACANCY OFFERED BY CIRDAFRICA

APPLICATIONS are invited from suitably qualified Kenyans for the post of Director of CIRDAFRICA, with effect from 1st July, 1985. ### Job description:

- (1) The director is the chief executive officer and legal representative of CIRDAFRICA responsible for the implementation of the centre's programmes and activities.
- (2) Directs the work of CIRDAFRICA in accordance with the policies, decisions, and programmes adopted by the governing council, and under the guidance of the executive committee and the technical committee.
- (3) Submits the governing council at each regular session, through the executive committee—
  - (a) a biennial report on the work of the centre;
  - (b) audited accounts for the previous biennium; and
  - (c) a programme of work and budget for the centre for the following biennium.
- (4) Convenes the sessions of the governing council, the executive committee, the technical committee and all other meetings of CIRDAFRICA and provides the secretariat for such meetings.
- (5) Recommends to the executive committee candidates for the senior professional posts of CIRDAFRICA for appointment in accordance with the policies and general standards laid down by the executive committee and or the governing council.
- (6) Appoints general services staff in accordance with the policies and general standards laid down by the governing council.
- (7) Provides leadership in raising funds to support CIRD-AFRIC programmes and promotes the centre's close relationship with the member states generally and the national I.R.D. centres in particular as well as with other supporting agencies.

### Qualifications and aptitudes:

- (a) A good university degree preferably in the agricultural sciences and at least ten (10) years of successful experience in a top executive position.
- (b) Candidates should be proficient in at least one and have a working knowledge of the three languages—English, French and Arabic.

Desirable qualifications.—Being head of an organization comprising of an international team of highly professional people and having to do with intricate bilateral and multilateral development co-operation programmes, the job requires someone equally qualified technically and with considerable experience in development problems at a fairly senior level. Besides, it requires a person of great integrity, magnanimity and human understanding who will not only be a living example of the team he leads, but above all, someone who can command the confidence and respect of both the member governments and the international community they collaborate with.

Salary scale.—D-1 i.e. US\$26,530 to 30,940. A post adjustment allowance is also payable as per O.A.U. regulations (at present 80 per cent of basic salary).

### Other conditions of service:

- (1) The appointment will be on contract of four (4) years renewable once only.

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given twelve (12) months of the commencement of the term the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee, fifty (50) per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee five (5) per cent of the said stand premium. All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of an A4 sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.

  (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

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"D.14.(1) Communications for the Kenya Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer when ready.

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.

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
