#### VACANCIES

APPLICATIONS are invited for the posts shown below. Completed application forms should reach the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, P.O. Box 30095, Nairobi, on or before 5th July, 1985.

Civil servant applicants and local authority officers should complete forms PSC. 2A (Revised) in triplicate (submitting the original through their heads of department) and cards PSC. 25 and 25A. Other applicants should complete forms PSC. 2 in triplicate and cards PSC. 24 and 24A.

These documents are obtainable either from the Secretary or other government offices and are issued free of charge.

Note

Incremental credits will be granted to successful candidates who are not civil servants for approved previous experience provided the maximum salary is not exceeded. They will also be eligible for benefits and privileges enjoyed by civil servants in accordance with existing government regulations.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Tourism and Wildlife:

Tourist Officer I (Three Posts) (No. 181/85)

Salary scale.—K£2,154 to 2,928 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be civil servants who have served in the tourist industry for at least three (3) years in a grade not below a tourist officer II (Job Group "J"). They should be mature, decisive, analytical and objective in addition to being able to deal with both local and international tourism.

Successful candidates will assist in running a section in the tourism department headquarters or a tourist office abroad and will be mainly concerned with implementation and follow-up on work programmes, hotel inspectorate, investigations, prosecutions and hotel classification or any other duties as may be assigned by a senior tourist officer.

Tourist Officer II (Four Posts) (No. 182/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,794 to 2,424 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be tourist officers III (Job Group "H") who must have served satisfactorily in their present grade for at least two (2) years. They should have completed an approved senior tourism management course at a recognized institution, and should have a thorough knowledge of the Hotels and Restaurants Act (Cap. 494), and the Tourist Industry Licensing Act (Cap. 381).

The successful candidates will be in charge of a team of tourist officers III and among other duties, they will be coordinating work programmes from overseas based tourist offices, analysing monthly, quarterly and annual reports from all overseas tourist offices and producing publicity and promotional material for Kenya tourist offices abroad and other related organizations.

Laboratory Technologist II (One Post) (No. 183/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2,010 p.a. PENSIONABLE of AGREEMENT.

Applicants must have served for a minimum period of three (3) years at the level of laboratory technologist III during which period they must have gained experience in laboratory analysis of more than one subject. They must have advanced certificate in laboratory technology or science laboratory advanced certificate from the Kenya Polytechnic or any other equivalent qualification. They should be conversant with testing procedures, evaluation of results and be able to draft technical reports.

The successful candidate will be stationed at the Wildlife and Fisheries Training Institute, Naivasha, where he will be involved with analysis of environmental pollutant, supervision of laboratory staff and maintenance of the laboratory supplies.

.. Laboratory Technologist III (One Post) (No. 184/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,128 to 1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of Kenya Certificate of Education or its equivalent with credits in any two approved

science subjects. They must also have successfully completed a three-year training course leading to the award of one of the following basic qualifications: biological laboratory technician ordinary certificate or science certificate or science laboratory technician ordinary certificate.

Serving officers at the level of laboratory technician grade I (Job Group "F") who have obtained one of the basic qualifications for direct appointment into this grade will also be considered. In both cases, applicants must have gained experience in laboratory analysis of more than one subject.

Duties will involve demonstration of various biological and chemical analysis related to wildlife and fisheries sciences.

The successful candidate will be deployed at the Wildlife Fisheries Training Institute, Naivasha.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Finance and Planning:

Range Ecologist I (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 185/85)

Salary scale.—K£2,154 to 2,928 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be Kenya citizen with a minimum of a bachelor of science degree in either of the following subjects: botany, zoology, ecology or range management and must have had a minimum of four (4) years of field experience in terrestial ecology and to have planned and conducted individual research projects. A post-graduate degree in any one of natural sciences or a post-graduate training in specialized fields like applications of remote sensing to the survey of natural resources including land use mapping, forestry, vegetation mapping, etc., will certainly be advantageous.

Applicants will be required to have had some experience in supervising scientific and technical staff on matters related to natural resource data acquisition and writing of technical reports. Knowledge of applied statistics, ground and aerial survey ecological monitoring techniques as well as application of remote sensing techniques to the survey of natural resources will be an asset.

Duties and responsibilities of this post will involve leading a team of range ecologists, technical assistants in evaluating vegetation trends in the country with emphasis in specified priority areas. The successful candidate will be required to implement specified work schedules related to ground truth data, collection, land use mapping and application of multistage concept of natural resource monitoring as inputs to the already established data bank in KREMU. He/she will be attached to Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit (KREMU) ground surveys section and will be answerable to the senior range ecologist.

Forester Grade I (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 186/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,794 to 2,424 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of a bachelor of science degree in forestry with an interest in application of remote sensing techniques and aerial photography to the inventory and survey forest resources. Knowledge of biostatistics or applied statistics and some field experience in forestry management will certainly be an asset.

Duties and responsibilities of this post will involve being attached to remote sensing section of Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit and being involved in the on-going programme of the application of satellite imagery and analysis of aerial photographs to monitoring and forest cover mapping in the country. Successful candidate will be expected to liaise along with other resource ecologists through the section head, with the forest department on some of the priority areas that require attention.

Photo-technician II (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 187/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2,010 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of East African Certificate of Education Division II with mathematics, chemistry, biology and geography. Applicants with East African Advanced Certificate of Education in science subjects preferably chemistry will definitely have an advantage. Applicants must equally be holders of professional certificates from recognized training institutions like the Kenya Polytechnic or I.T.C. of Netherlands in aerial photography and photoprocessing for resource mapping. They must also have had at least four (4) years' working experience

in photo-lab. or dark-room management in an established technical institution which has a bias on processing aerial photographs for survey work or topographical mapping. Knowledge of infra-red colour processing, use of cibachachrome material, printing and processing of satellite imagery both false colour and black and white imagery and experience in making of photomosaic will be an added advantage.

Successful candidates will be attached to remote sensing of the Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit and will be involved in the management of KREMU's photo-lab. photographic library and will be responsible for the direction of other phototechnicians who will work under him in meeting KREMU's longterm photographic requirements.

Photo-technician III (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 188/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,128 to 1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of East African Certificate of Education Division III with credits in mathematics, chemistry and geography. They must have had at least three (3) years' working experience in an established photo-lab. or a well-established technical institution. A professional certificate training in a photographic processing and in particular colour processing and handling of both mechanical and electronic cameras will be a definite advantage.

Successful candidate will be attached to Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit sensing section. He/she will essentially be responsible in conjunction with the other phototechnician for taking, processing and printing of all KREMU's photographic materials, including making of slides and any other photographic or dark-room duties that will be assigned to him by the section head.

Coding Technician III (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 189/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,128 to 1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be in possession of Kenya Certificate of Education Division III or its accepted equivalent with credits in mathematics, biology and geography. They must have knowledge and proven working experience of at least two years in computer programming in any one of the languages including data processing. Candidates in possession of Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education will have an added advantage.

The successful candidate will be attached to data management section of Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring and will be responsible for the following:

- (i) Supervision of data entry and verification.
- (ii) To edit coding sheets and computer files containing KREMUS's data.
- (iii) Coding and/or data entry of various sets of geographic and natural resources data.
- (iv) To operate KREMU's mini-computer including day-today running of programmes.
- (v) To undertake simple programming tasks.

Laboratory Technologist III (One Post) (Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit) (No. 190/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,128 to 1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be in possession of Kenya Certificate of Education or its accepted equivalent with credits in chemistry and biology and must have successfully completed a three-year training course leading to the award of either "O" level or BLT "O" level or BLT "O" level.

Serving officers at the level of laboratory technician grade with BLT or SLT "O" level with a minimum of five (5) years' experience in biological science laboratories are equally eligible for consideration.

Incremental credits will however, be awarded to a successful candidate with proven experience in accordance with the scheme of service.

Duties and responsibilities of this post will involve being responsible for the efficient running and management of Kenya Rangeland Ecological Monitoring Unit's dry and wet laboratories. He/she will essentially be expected to carry out normal laboratory analysis and in particular chemical value and food selection of grazing herbivorous. He/she will be answerable to the senior range ecologist.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Co-operative Development:

Lecturer Grade II (One Post) (Management Section)
(No. 191/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,794 to 2,424 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be university graduates with a degree in either economics, business administration, agricultural economics or business education. They should have three (3) years' proven ability and experience in management and administration of co-operatives or teaching in higher courses. Serving officers with at least three (3) years' satisfactory service in the grade of lecturer III and, with diploma in co-operative management and proven administration or teaching ability in the related work will also be considered.

Successful candidate will be required to teach on management functions, personnel and office management, co-operative knowledge, statistics and economics. Work also involves preparation of educational materials and teaching aids; undertaking research in specific fields; setting and marking examinations course administration and or perform such other extracurricula duties as may be assigned by the college.

Lecturer Grade II (One Post) (Distant Education) (No. 192/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,794 to 2,424 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be university graduates with a degree in commerce, economics, business administration/education and, or diploma in adult education with three (3) years' proven administrative or teaching experience in an adult training institution. Candidates with a diploma in co-operative management and adult education with proven ability and experience of less than five (5) years in co-operative education will be eligible. Serving officers with three (3) years' satisfactory service in the grade of lecturer TII or comparable position in co-operative education will also be considered.

Successful candidates will be required to take charge of distant education programmes for officials and staff of the co-operative movement. Work involves administration of correspondence courses units and radio programmes and, or such other duties as may be assigned by the principal.

Lecturer Grade III (One Post) (Accounts Section) (No. 193/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2;010 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must possess a degree in commerce, business administration or management/administration with accounting as the major field of study. Candidates with C.P.A. II certificate and, with accounting or auditing experience in government, private or co-operative sectors will be eligible. Serving officers with a diploma in co-operative management and three (3) years' accounting or auditing experience will also be considered.

Successful candidate will be required to teach co-operative accounts, business mathematics, book-keeping and accounts to basic courses at the college, comprising mainly secretary-managers, book-keepers, and accounts clerks of co-operative societies. Work also involves preparation in curriculum developments, setting and marking tests, course administration and, or performing such other extra-curricula duties as may be assigned by the principal.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Water Development:

Senior Inspector Electrical (Water Services) (Six Posts) (No. 194/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2,010 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should have attained a good general education, preferably school certificate of education. They must have approved electrical training preferably City and Guilds electrical technician certificate final grade or its equivalent and must have had at least two (2) years' post training experience as inspector (electrical) dealing with installations, operations and maintenance of low, medium and high voltage electrical machinery. They should be conversant with water supply electrical installations including borehole submersible pumps, motor/control gear and diesel generators. They must be familiar with the current official electrical regulations, and must be in possession of a minimum class "C" electrician licence.

Alternatively candidates must hold a grade I wireman trade test certificate or its equivalent and preferably should have served as an apprenticeship in an electrical trade followed by at least three (3) years in a supervisory position at a level

equivalent to an inspector (electrical) in the civil service. They should be familiar with water supply electrical services including submersible pumpsets, motor/control gear and diesel generators, etc. They must be in possession of a minimum of class "C" electrician licence and conversant with current official electrical regulations.

In either case preference should be given to holders of class "A" and "B" electrician licence.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Transport and Communications:

Senior Laboratory Technologist (Four Posts) (Materials Branch)
(No. 195/85)

Salary scale.—K£2,154 to 2,928 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants will be required to have served for at least three (3) years in a road pavement design establishment.

They should be competent in carrying out field investigations for pavement design materials, laboratory duties, interpretation of soil data, maintenance of laboratory equipment and preparation of simple pavement design reports. They should be capable of running a construction control laboratory in support of construction under contract on their own.

Senior Survey Assistant (One Post) (Roads Branch) (No. 196/85)

Salary scale.—K£2,154 to 2,928 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be civil servants in possession of Kenya Certificate of Education or its equivalent. They must have passed the ordinary diploma in land surveying examination from the Kenya Polytechnic or Government Occupational Test Grade I certificate in land surveying or their equivalent.

The applicants must in addition have at least nine (9) years of post-qualification experience in survey activities and operations of which six (6) years must have been on surveys related to route location geometric highway design and construction.

They must have served at the grade of survey assistant I (Job Group "J") at least for three (3) years. They should have considerable experience in the use and maintenance of survey instruments and organizing field parties and their related activities.

The successful candidates will be responsible to the senior superintending surveyor for road and aerodromes survey activities and supervision of a team of survey assistant technicians working on various survey projects.

Survey Assistant II (Three Posts) (Road Branch) (No. 197/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2,010 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of Kenya Certificate of Education or its acceptable equivalent. They must have ordinary diploma in land surveying from a recognized institution or government occupational test grade I certificate in surveying or their acceptable equivalent.

They must in addition have at least three (3) years of post qualification experience in topographical and engineering survey, including triangulation, trilateration and the use of EDM equipment, tacheometry, photo-interpretation and the use of aerial photography, highway route location and settling out of roads works. They should also have comprehensive knowledge of land survey methods, computation and adjustment and they must have served in the grade of survey assistant III (Job Group "G") for at least three (3) years.

The successful applicants will be required to carry out, with minimum supervision, general survey duties requiring specialized knowledge and experience in road survey supervision and control of his/her own field survey limit.

Senior Inspector, Buildings (One Post) (Structural Department) (Re-advertisement) (No. 198/85)

Salary scale.—K£1,494 to 2,010 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must have a minimum of Kenya Certificate of Education with at least credit in mathematics and in possession of ordinary diploma in building or civil engineering or construction technician certificate part II from the Kenya Polytechnic or its equivalent.

Experience.—Applicants should have a minimum of three (3) years' post diploma experience. Serving draughtsmen grade III who satisfy practical experience requirements will be considered.   - (b) The amount of actual capital available for development with banker's letter or other evidence of financial status in support.

- (c) The manner in which it is proposed to raise the balance required for development, if any.
- (d) Full details of both residential and/or commercial properties owned by the applicant in the municipality.

- (f) In case of companies, names of directors to be included.
- 5. The successful allottee of a plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within thirty (30) days of notification that his/her application has been successful, the stand premium and proportion of the annual rent together with conveyancing, stamp duty, registration fees, contributions in lieu of rates, roads and drains charges and survey fees. In default of payment within the specified time, the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allocations and the applicant shall have no claim to the plot.

#### General Conditions

- 1. The grant will be made under the provision of the Government Lands Act/Trust Lands Act, and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap. 281) or the Registered Land Act (Cap. 300) as the case may be.
- 2. The grant will be issued in the name of the allotee as given in letter of application and will be subject to the special conditions set out below.
- 3. The term of the grant will be for ninety-nine (99) years from the first day of the month following the issue of the letter of allotment.

#### Special Conditions

1. No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external afterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the local authority. The Commissioner of Lands shall not

give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.

2. The lessee shall within six (6) calendar months of the actual registration of the lease submit in triplicate to the local authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and a system of drainage for the disposal of sewage surface and sullage water) drawings elevations and specifications of the buildings the lessee proposes to erect on the land and shall within twenty-four (24) months of the actual registration of the lease complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the commissioner:

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in or implied by the Government Lands Act, if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the commmissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

- 3. The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.
- 4. Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that she/he/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within twelve (12) months of the actual registration of the lease, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the lessee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund the lessee 25 per cent of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the building period no refund shall be made.

- 5. The land buildings shall only be used for residential and commercial purposes.
- 6. The building shall not cover more than 50 per cent of the area of the land if used for residential purposes and 75 per cent of the area of the land if used for shops, offices and flats or such lesser area than may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.
- 7. The lessee shall not subdivide the land without prior written consent of the Commissioner of Lands.
- 8. The lessee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until special condition No. 2 has been performed.
- 9. The lessee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven (7) days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid.
- 10. The lessee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess.
- 11. Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to higher standard the lessee shall pay to the commissioner on demand such proportion of the cost of such construction as the commissioner may assess.
- 12. The lessee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any government of local authority upon

the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President of the Republic of Kenya, in lieu thereof.

- 13. The President of Kenya or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground and the lessee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of main or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.
- 14. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rental payable hereunder after the expiration of the thirty-third (33rd) and sixty-sixth (66th) years of the term granted. Such rental will be at a rate of 4 per cent of unimproved freehold value of the land as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands.
