Kenya Engineering Workers Union and

Southern Engineering Co. Ltd.

Issues in dispute:

Basic minimum wages. General wage increase. Probationary period. Annual paid leave. Sick leave. Shift differential. Maternity leave. Retirement benefits. Leave travelling allowance. Safari allowance. Casual workers. Transport. House allowance. Redundancy (severance pay). Effective date and duration.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Southern Engineering Co. Ltd., shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 28th November, 1984, 25th January, 1985 and 8th May, 1985 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

#### Award

3. The parties are in disagreement over the question of whether they should go ahead to review the terms and conditions of service of the workers who have since ceased to be employed by the respondents.

The Southern Engineering Co. Ltd., was until 30th June, 1980, owned by three shareholders namely Messrs. A. T. Crook, Trainer and Kester. This company was later bought by Messrs. A. Kurji and M. Kurji, who carried on this business for sometime but failed later on.

The claimants stated that the Southern Engineering Company Limited was a member of the Engineering and Allied Industries Employers Association up to July, 1980, the time they closed down and declared their former employees redundant. The claimants further alleged that as soon as the respondents effected mass redundancy they reopened the business and engaged casual workers under new management.

During 1982 the claimants submitted proposals for a fresh agreement which contained 29 issues and after a series of meetings the parties agreed on some and reached a deadlock on fourteen issues which are now before the court in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Disputes Act. At the end of concilliation the parties did not agree on the following proposals as demanded by the union.

Wages, group I.—Union's demand for minimum wage was KISh. 940 per month. Management offered KISh. 550 per month.

Group II.—Ungraded artisans, welders, machine operators, gas welders, spray painters, filters, turners, electricians, carpenters, machine attendants. The union demanded KSh. 1,400 per month and management offered KSh. 700 per month. Probationary period. Annual leave. Sick leave. Shift differential. Maternity leave. Leave travelling allowance. Retirement benefits (gratuity). Safari allowance. Casual workers. Transport. House allowance. Effective date and duration of agreement. Redundancy.

There was no movement by the parties on the items mentioned above.

The claimants demanded a severance pay of thirty (30) days pay per every completed year of service or part thereof shall be paid to the affected employee on redundancy.

The respondents suggested a severance pay of ten (10) days wages to an employee for each completed year of service.

Lastly, the claimants proposed a review of job classifications.

The respondents submitted that until 30th June, 1980, the company was owned by three shareholders who later sold it to Messrs. A. Kurji and M. Gurji. The respondents have since then suffered heavy losses in their operations and on 31st July, 1984, they were forced to cease operation. The respondents have since last year wound up and sent their former employees on terminal leave which was due to expire on 31st August, 1984. The employees were to collect their terminal benefits then.

The respondents concluded their submissions by pointing out that this dispute has been overtaken by events as they no longer operate and do not employ any of the claimants' members. Furthermore it serves no useful purpose to pursue the matter further. At this juncture the claimants replied by insisting that the respondents were still in existence but were only avoiding to fulfil certain obligations that affected their former employees.

The respondents reiterated their earlier stand that the case be dismissed as the owners of the company had handled the matter in accordance with the Trade Disputes Act.

The court after careful consideration finds that the claimants' demands have been overtaken by events but the court feels that the respondents should honour the offers they made on general wage increase of 6 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1983, and 1st August, 1984. The court therefore awards that the respondents should be deemed to have awarded a wage increase of 6 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1983 and 6 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1983 and 6 per cent, with effect from 1st August, 1984. These increases should be taken into account when workers' terminal benefits are worked out. The court makes no award on all the other items in dispute.

- (b) Refusal by the Kenya Railways Corporation to refund J. N. Were half of the salary withheld during the period of his interdiction.

THE Railways and Harbours Union (K) shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Kenya Railways Corporation shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents. 2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 20th and 21st May, 1985, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

#### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 20th September, '1983, duly signed by the parties was received by the court, on 31st May, 1984, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. Were was first employed by the respondents, the then East African Railways and Harbours administration, as a junior clerk on 5th February, 1952. He rose through the ranks over the years and was finally promoted to the position of Station Master Grade RB. Executive II on the 10th March, 1972. He served in this capacity until his retirement after 28 years' service with the corporation.

The dispute before the court arose after Mr. Were was arrested in early March, 1978, in connection with the stealing of KISh. 360 which he collected as stacking plot charges. This amount was paid to him by cheque by Messrs. Shah & Patel during July, 1971. The amount was to cover stacking plot fees for the period July to December, 1971. While the case was pending before the court, Mr. Were was interdicted from duty on 21st March, 1978. The case was subsequently heard and Mr. Were was acquitted under section 210 of the Criminal Procedure Code. The claimants expected that the interdiction would be lifted after acquittal and the amount so far deducted could therefore be refunded. The respondents instead, preferred departmental charges against Mr. Were in accordance with the staff regulation G 9 (f) and statutory provisions under section 22 of the East African Railways Corporation (Appointments and Discipline) Regulations, 1974 for failing to account for, and remit to the chief accountant the amount of KSh. 360 paid to him in July, 1971, as stacking plot fees. He denied the charges and appealed to the managing director, and the claimants too made representation on his behalf. Further, he handed over to his lawyer the issue of his half-pay which was withheld by the respondents during his interdiction. All the issues presented by Mr. Were were subsequently rejected by the respondents on grounds that they had acted within the regulations governing staff appointments and discipline and as such there was nothing to merit respondents' further consideration.

The claimants then reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and an investigation was carried out and the ministry's finding and recommendation as conveyed to the parties on 13th July, 1982, upheld the action taken by the respondents in reducing Mr. Were's salary by one year's increment. With regard to the second issue concerning half salary deducted during interdiction, the ministry recommended that the amount be refunded to Mr. Were. The claimants rejected the findings and recommendation and filed the dispute with the Industrial Court for arbitration.

The main argument advanced by the claimants rested upon the statutory provisions of section 19 (4) of the E. A. Railways Corporation (Appointment and Discipline) Regulations, 1974, which states:

"Where disciplinary or criminal proceeding have been taken or instituted against an officer under interdiction and such an officer is not dismissed or otherwise punished under these regulations, the whole of any salary withheld under paragraph (3) of this regulation shall be restored to him upon the conclusion of such proceedings. If any punishment other than dismissal is inflicted, the officer may be refunded a portion of the salary withheld as the result of his interdiction for failing to account for any money collected by his subordinate officer on his behalf. In fact documentary evidence produced before the court confirmed that Mr. Were banked the cheque for KSh. 360 and withdrew an equivalent amount in cash after the goods clerk had handed over to him all the cash and cheques collected that day for banking. Indeed, he himself completed the cash remittance note and bank pay-in-slip which included the said cheque as part of the station's earnings. As a station master, he violated traffic accounts manual clause 1021 (b) the relevant provisions of which states that:

9 (b) "Station masters must sign all cash remittances notes and satisfy themselves by an inspection of the respective cash books, that the correct amount of earnings on account of coaching, goods and miscellaneous is remitted."

The court is satisfied that Mr. Were was duty bound to account for any unremitted amount. It is certainly odd to find that Mr. Were decided to refund KSh. 360 after seven years had lapsed and without any official debit advice being issued to him in respect of cash shortage at Nyahururu. His action goes a long way to prove his effort to cover this offence. The court is therefore satisfied that disciplinary action taken against Mr. Were under the staff regulations was due to non-accountability and negligence and, certainly had nothing to do with the theft charge brought against him for which he was acquitted.

In these circumstances the court cannot find the respondents to be at fault in this dispute. The court notes that Mr. Were was normally retired thereafter.

Under the circumstances, the court rejects the claimants' demand made on his behalf for a refund of half salary deducted during interdiction and reinstatement of a year's increment withheld as a disciplinary punishment.

The cout must add that this was a speculative claim without merit at all.

Whereas the claimants relied on the foregoing provisions, the respondents on the other hand argued that since Mr. Were suffered the punishment of reduction in salary by one increment for a period of one year, and considering the nature of the offence he committed which could have resulted in irrecoverable loss o frevenue if not detected, the respondents applied their discretion under the regulation not to refund the withheld portion of the salary.

The claimants also argued that the departmental charges preferred against Mr. Were were substantially the same which had featured in the criminal court against him and for which he was acquitted.

The court has carefully analysed the arguments put forward by the claimants and it appears that they have ignored the fact that Mr. Were was in-charge of Nyahururu Railway Station and was the accounting officer on behalf of the respondents. The fact that KSh. 360 was paid to the goods clerk Nyahururu, and not to himself did not exempt him from being blamed Mkiria Mukubitu.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Southern Engineering Co. Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi, on 28th November, 1984, 25th January, 1985, and 8th May, 1985, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

This dispute was consolidated with cause No. 1 of 1984 affecting Evanson Wafula, who was also declared redundant by the respondents.

#### Award

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 2nd June, 1984, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 14th August, 1984, along with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents were until the time they closed down due to lack of business based in Mombasa. The claimants and respondents disagreed over the action of the respondents to retire a number of employees who were advanced in age and the complainants in this case were among them. Those affected employees were on retirement paid retirement benefits as laid down in the memorandum of agreement between Eugineering and Allied Industries Employers Association to which the respondents were affiliated to at the material time and the claimants.

The relevant clause in that agreement states as follows:

"Retirement benefits":

#### (a) Gratuity:

"A gratuity for long service employees who were ineligible to join the provident fund scheme is to be calculated as follows:

After 1 to 5 years service, 1 week's pay for each completed year. From 6 to 10 years service,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  weeks pay for completed year. After 10 years service, 2 weeks pay for each completed year."

(b) Gratuity for long service employees who join the provident fund, due to age, do not qualify for such benefit and who have served for a long time with the company will be calculated in accordance with the following rules:

"1. Employees who have already left the service of the association shall not be deemed within the scope of this agreement.

2. The only service catered for under this agreement will be the service prior to July, 1963, or when the individual company's provident fund was introduced.

3. The formular for calculating this payment shall be the same as that introduced by the concilliation agreement in respect of employees inelegible to join the provident fund (see (a) above).

4. The starting date would be 1st July, 1945.

5. An employee who is entitled to a benefit under the gratuity scheme as above should be entitled to it if he losses his employment for any reason other than on resignation before completing fifteen years of service with his employer or on disciplinary grounds."

The claimants stated that the respondents decided to close down unilaterally without following the established redundancy procedure by securing claimants agreement. The respondents issued a circular letter to each of the six employees in this dispute advising them that they were in a bad financial situation and were finding it difficult to trade as they were incurring a substantial loss each month. It was therefore not possible to keep them in employment but to retire them and pay them their normal dues. The claimants protested at the respondents unilateral action and approached the Coast Provincial Labour Officer to intervene. It was then agreed at a meeting held between the provincial labour officer and the parties concerned to pay all employees their redundancy compensation. However, the respondentse failed to honour this commitment and the claimants therefore reported a formal trade dispute to the Minister for Labour in accordance with the Trade Disputes Act. The Ministry of Labour's investigations revealed that the respondents had issued notices to their '180 employees on 1st July, 1980, to the effect that their services would no longer be required after the end of the month since the company was closing down. It was also found that the respondents retiring age was normally 55 years. The six employees affected had either reached or passed the retiring age. It was noted that the respondents should have retired them before July, 1980, when they served them with notice letters on the grounds of redundancy. It was considered to be an unfair labour practice for the respondents to have changed their minds to their financial benefit. The investigator recommended that the Southern Engineering Company Ltd. should pay the six employees their severance pay on grounds of redundancy as provided for by the parties collective bargaining agreement. The respondents stated that during the month of May and June, 1980, the old management of the respondents did everything to save the possible collapse of the company. As at the beginning of June there was no intention to declare any employee redundant. However, there were a number of employees who had passed the normal retiring age and were quite advanced in age and the respondents decided to retire them. The understanding produced by the claimants as appendix 2 in their submission in cause 71 of 1984 referred to employees who were declared redundant and not those retired. The respondents further wished to inform the court that the company was later taken over by new management who eventually have been forced to close down. The respondents retired the six employees in good faith with a view to saving the company from total collapse. The serious financial problem the respondents were experiencing was confirmed by the claimants when two months later they accepted redundancy terms.

Finally, the respondents stated that the present case by the claimants is an attempt to have double benefits, as they are demanding that the affected employees should get retirement benefits as well as redundancy compensation. The respondents therefore ask the court to dismiss the case.

The court after careful consideration of all the points raised in the parties submissions awards the six employees redundancy compensation in accordance with the parties collective agreement. The court upholds the Ministry of Labour's finding and recommendation in this dispute. The court would like to clarify that these workers are not entitled to retirement benefits and redundancy payments. They are entitled to redundancy payments only, i.e. the one that is financially more advantageous. They should be paid the balance due to them forthwith.
