# THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 55 of 1985

Parties:

African Retail Traders Ltd.

and

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers

#### Rectification of Award

THE court announced its award in the above dispute on 25th June, 1986, and the court stated in the last paragraph of its award:

After careful consideration of the parties submissions the court finds that Moses Atuti deserved dismissal but in view of the evidence given by Mr. Akidiva in the criminal court it is abvious that Mr. Akidiva was the real culprit. Under these circumstances and in view of the fact that the criminal case against Mr. Atuti was withdrawn, the court awards that the respondent should refund Mr. Atuti the sum of Sh. 12,700 which money belongs to Mr. Atuti and which had accumulated in his security account.

The respondents have moved the court to rectify the award by amending the figure of Sh. 12,700 to read Sh. 5,256.85 as this was the amount lying in the grievant's security account and which the court intended to be refunded to the grievant.

The court gave every opportunity to the claimants and the grievant's advocate to appear before the court to make their views known on the matter but they neglected to do so.

The court accordingly asked the respondents personnel and administration manager to depone to the fact that the amount in the grievant's security account was Sh. 5,256.85 and not Sh. 12,700. The court has now received an affidavit from the personnel and administration manager and after having perused it is satisfied that the court made an error in its award by stating that the grievant should be refunded Sh. 12,700. The court intended the grievant to be refunded the amount standing in his security account and the court is satisfied that it was Sh. 5,256.85 and not Sh. 12,700.

The court therefore rectifies its award under the provisions of section 16 (5) of the Trade Disputes Act by deleting the figure of Sh. 12,700 from the aforesaid award and substituting therefore the figure of Sh. 5,256.85.

# THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 22 of 1988

Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers and

Olweny & Associates

Issue in Dispute:

Dismissal of 33 employees

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Olweny & Associates shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 22nd February, 1989 and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The court could not hear the dispute earlier because the claimants were not ready to proceed with the hearing.

#### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 4th May, 1987, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 12th April, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents engage in land surveying and planning consultancy. In 1985 when the grievants were dismissed, the respondents had a total work-force of 120 employees.

The grievants in this dispute were employed by the respondents on different dates and years in various professional and nonprofessional fields. The list of the grievants is as follows:

The grievants were dismissed on 31st January, 1986, on the ground that the respondents were experiencing financial difficulties due to lack of professional work.

This dispute was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and the findings were that the grievants' were unlawfully declared redundant. The Ministry of Labour recommended the following:

- The grievants were declared redundant and they be paid terminal dues as per the relevant clause of the collective agreement covering redundancy.
- Each one of them should be refunded their contributions plus interest accruing which they made towards the so called co-operative union Olasco.
- Finally each one of them should be paid two months salary as general compensation for the unfair loss of paid employment.

This decision was turned down by the respondents and now the matter is before the court for consideration.

The court notes that this matter was reported to the Ministry of Labour and a conciliator appointed to assist the parties in reaching a settlement. After several conciliation meetings the parties, on 17th June, 1986, were able to reach an agreement on this matter and they were to be paid up to 21st January, 1986 only.

Subsequently the grievants' terminal dues were deposited with the provincial labour office for onward payment to the grievants. The court is surprised that after this informal conciliation and settlement the official investigator again from Nakuru made the aforesaid recommendations which to say the least are highly questionable because to begin with there was no collective agreement in force between the parties and the workers were subject to the general wages order. The court cannot therefore give any weight to the ministry's recommendations.

The court finds that both parties were at fault to some extent in this dispute because the respondents' circulars confused the workers and they stopped working on 21st January, 1986. After considering all aspects of the matter, the court finds that a payment of half a month's salary to each one of the grievants in addition to what was deposited at the Nakuru Labour Office would meet the dictates of justice and the court so awards.

Finally the Olasco issue is not within the scope of this dispute and the court must refrain from making any findings in respect thereto.

Demotion of Richard Otieno.

THE Transport and Allied Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and the Kenya Bus Services (Mombasa) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 23rd February, 1989, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

#### Award

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 13th April, 1987, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 26th April, 1988, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. Otieno was employed by the respondents on 12th July, 1976, as a bus conductor. On 22nd May, 1985, he was selected through interview to train as a ticket machine clerk. He completed his two months training and thereafter was appointed ticket machine clerk and placed on three months probation.

This dispute revolves around the grievants' promotion from P.S.V. bus conductor to ticket machine clerk and his subsequent demotion to the former post of a P.S.V. bus conductor.

The court notes that Mr. Otieno started training as a ticket machine clerk on 22nd May, 1985, and successfully completed two months training. Thereafter Mr. Otieno was placed on three months probation and the court further notes that it was during his probation period that Mr. Otieno was verbally demoted back to his former job of a P.S.V. bus conductor. The grievant did not resume his former duties of a conductor until January 1986, and the respondents did not take steps to enforce their decision either before that date.

While the court agrees with the respondents that the promotion and deployment of staff is a management prerogative, it does not agree with their action in this dispute.

The court is of the opinion that Mr. Otieno was not performing duties of a P.S.V. bus conductor from mid July 1985 up to the end of December 1985 and the respondents are aware of it. How Mr. Otieno performed the duties of a ticket machine clerk is a different thing all together but the fact remains that for some five months he worked in a higher grade. He was certainly entitled to salary obtainable in that higher grade.

The court having carefully considered the parties' submissions in this dispute finds that Mr. Otieno was supposed to earn a salary of a ticket machine clerk from 1st August, 1985, upto December 1985. The court accordingly awards that the respondents should pay the grievants his arrears covering the period 1st August to 30th December, 1985.

The court appreciates that promotion is a management prerogative but in this case certain facts came to light which in the opinion of the court did not lead to an impartial appraisal of Mr. Otieno's job as a ticket machine clerk and the court therefore directs that Mr. Otieno should be given another chance on a probation basis for three months during and after which his work should be appraised by officers other than those who dealt with the matter during the material time in 1985 and the respondents' decision taken then shall be final and binding. His three months probation should begin on 1st June, 1989.

The court has carefully examined and evaluated the submission by the parties and finds no grounds for disturbing the recognition agreement existing between the respondents and the interested party. The claimants demand is accordingly rejected.




