3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 3rd June, 1988, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 10th October, 1988, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are a limited liability company. They are situated in Kakamega District of the Western Province of Kenya. The respondents are an agro-based industry engaged in the collection of latex from the pawpaws sold to them by farmers in the region. The latex is processed to make various products.

The respondents employ a permanent workforce of 14 unionizable employees. They, in addition to the permanent labour, engage seasonal employees whose number varies from season to season.

The grievants in this dispute were employed by the respondents on different dates between 1979 and 1981 respectively. The grievants had served the respondents for period ranging from three to five years.

The court notes that each and every grievant in this dispute had signed an agency agreement. Further to that the grievants were not paid monthly salaries but commissions, depending on the job done. This explicitly proves that there was no employer/employee relationship to occasion an issue of redundancy.

After having considered carefully the submissions made by the parties, the court finds that the grievants were independent contractors and were not in any way employees of the respondents.

In view of this the grievants could not have been a subject of redundancy exercise.

The claimants' demands are accordingly rejected.

This dispute affects about 111 unionizable employees and arose when the parties were negotiating for the renewal of their latest collective agreement which expired on 30th April, 1988.

After careful consideration of the parties' submissions and taking into account the present financial difficulties of the respondents the court award as follows:
