THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 51 of 1989

Parties:

Kenya Engineering Workers Union
and

Steel Fasteners Limited.

Issues in dispute:

1. Implementation of the collective bargaining agreement.
2. Five months pay to the employees.

THE Kenya Engineering Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the claimants and Steel Fasteners Limited shall hereinafter be referred to as the respondents.

2. This dispute was mentioned on 31st July, 1989, and was fixed for hearing on 11th September, 1989. However, on that date the hearing was stood-over-generally. The dispute was subsequently mentioned several times and its hearing postponed three times. This was partly due to the parties wish to settle the matter out of court and partly due to the grievants' insistence that they be represented by an advocate of their own choice instead of the union.

On 17th October, 1990, the parties agreed to settle this dispute on the basis of an agreement between them which is appendix 7 of the claimants' memorandum. And on 2nd September, 1991, this court finally allowed Mr. Opondo-Asin, advocate to represent the grievants.

The respondents, however, did not submit their version of calculations of the grievants' dues despite ample time given to them to do so and the calculations were made *ex-parte*.

Although the parties never made any formal submissions in view of the above they had filed their written submissions which will be briefly outlined herebelow.

AWARD

3. The Notification of the Dispute Form "A" dated 14th April, 1989, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 10th July, 1989, together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The respondents are an engineering firm engaged in steel rolling business. They are situated in Kikuyu Division of Kiambu District. This dispute covers a total of 71 unionizable employees of the respondents.

This dispute revolves around failure/refusal by the respondents to implement a two years parties' collective agreement for the period 1st May, 1986, and 30th April, 1988. The respondents also have been accused of refusing to pay five (5) months salaries to the employees for the period from February 1988 to June 1988.

The claimants submitted that, the parties had voluntarily negotiated and concluded a two years' collective agreement on 5th November, 1987. Subsequently the said agreement was registered by the court on 15th February, 1987, as R.C.A. No. 42 of 1988.

However, the respondents did not implement the new terms and conditions of employment stipulated in the above agreement. Consequently, on 30th August, 1988, a trade dispute was reported to the Minister for Labour. The claimants further submitted that, while the dispute was being conciliated by the Ministry of Labour, the respondents did agree to implement the entire C.B.A. except for the wages clause. The claimants stated that the respondents in refusing to implement the wage clause part 1 (a) and (b) respectively denied the employees their general wage increases. As a result, the employees did not get 12 per cent wage increase for the first year and a similar increase of 12 per cent for the second year or a total of 24 per cent for the two years period. In addition the employees were not paid five months salaries for the period between 1st February and 30th June, 1988. The claimants emphasized that in the course of conciliation the parties had entered into a supplementary agreement on 22nd July, 1987, under the chairmanship of Kiambu District Labour Officer and it was clear to the parties that the respondents were the ones dealing with the claimants.

The claimants stated that the respondents' motive in refusing to implement the clause on wages was to deny the workers their general wage increases entitlement under the collective agreement.

The calculations below indicate that 51 grievants in this dispute were not granted their dues in salary increases, housing and travelling allowances for a period of 29 months, giving rise to a claim of KSh. 256,641.20.

The respondents submitted that they had sometimes early in 1987 leased their premises to M/s. Fixo-Fasteners. The respondents stated that M/s. Fixo-Fasteners on leasing the premises also undertook to take over all the operations of the factory plus all the employees at the existing terms and conditions of employment. The employees were also to be paid their severance pay by instalments spread over 6 months starting with January 1988.

The respondents informed the court that the agreement effecting the handing over of the company and employees to the M/s. Fixo-Fasteners was signed by all the interested parties namely: the respondents (Steel Fasteners) M/s. Fixo-Fasteners

and claimants respectively and witnessed by two labour officers at the Kiambu Labour Office.

The respondents further submitted that Fixo-Fasteners were approached by the claimants with proposals to negotiate terms and conditions of employment for the unionizable employees. The parties on their own went ahead and negotiated and concluded two years collective agreement on 27th November, 1987. The collective agreement was effective from 1st May, 1986 expiring on 30th April, 1988. This is the collective agreement which was registered by the court as R.C.A. No. 42 of 1988.

The respondents further stated that M/s. Fixo-Fasteners did not fulfill all the terms of the lease. Subsequently the premises were repossessed by Steel Fasteners while the collective agreement between M/s. Fixo-Fasteners and claimants was still in force. The respondents stressed that, they were not a party to the collective agreement in dispute and had no basis of implementing it. The respondents insisted they are not liable to pay salaries to employees who were not in their employment at the material time they leased the premises. They advised the claimants to direct their claims to the M/s. Fixo-Fasteners.

In respect of five (5) months salaries February 1988 up to June 1988, the respondents stressed that the factory was closed down and the keys deposited with the high court. The high court had issued an order restraining either respondents or M/s. Fixo-Fasteners from operating the factory. They argued that during these five months the grievants were not working and are not entitled to any payment.

The respondents urged the court to find that the collective agreement in question was not binding on them and that they are not liable to pay claimants anything.

As stated earlier on the basis of the parties wish to settle the matter as per Appendix 7 of the claimant's memorandum, the court deems it unnecessary to rule on the merits or otherwise of the parties submissions but instead endorses the calculations arrived at by the grievants' advocate in respect of arrears for the 29 months and salary dues for the five (5) months for each of the 71 grievants as tabulated herein above and awards accordingly.

The court must record that the respondents despite being given every opportunity repeatedly by the court through the registrar failed to appear and/or give their version of the amount due to the workers.

Issue in dispute:

"Wrongful, unjustifiable and/or unfair dismissal of Mr. Mwacharo Chirunga, ex-gangman RC. 11 C/No. 109846 by District Civil Engineer, Mombasa."

Dates of hearing: 10th and 17th September, 1991.

AWARD

THE Notification of Dispute, Form "A", dated 12th June, 1990, and duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 21st March, 1991, along with the statutory certificate signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievant was employed by the respondents on 3rd February, 1981, as a gangman wages staff. He was promoted to gangman RC. 2 on 1st September, 1984, a position he held until his dismissal on 10th October, 1988, for alleged absenteeism.

The incident which led to the dismissal of the grievant occurred on 18th July and 3rd August, 1988, when he absented himself from duty without permission contrary to personnel regulation A. 2 (c).

The claimants took up the matter on behalf of the grievant with the respondents but the latter refused to either reinstate him or reduce his dismissal to normal termination. The claimants then reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour, who accepted it and appointed Mr. A. O. Ambenge of Mombasa Labour Office to investigate the matter. On 25th May, 1990, the chief industrial relations officer released his report to the parties in which he recommended "that Mr. Chirunga's dismissal be reduced to normal termination and that he be paid his full benefits in accordance with the parties' collective bargaining agreement."

The claimants accepted the recommendations as a basis of settlement, but the respondents rejected it, and the matter is now before the court for consideration.

The claimants submitted that, in breach of the rules and regulations which govern disciplinary matters, the respondents wrongly dismissed the grievant under personnel regulation A. 2 (c). They contended that the said regulation does not carry dismissal powers, but regulation G. 13 (e).

The claimants told the court that the respondents are applying double standards when dealing with their employees; and, in support of their case, they produced service record of one Mr. Jume Okuku, who had twenty-eight (28) cases of absenteeism, and yet he was not dismissed from service. The claimants told the court that Mr. Okuku was subsequently terminated on public interest.

The claimants, therefore, contended that, although they did not support absenteeism, the respondents should have terminated the grievant's services as they had done with the other three ex-employees, who had, in fact, worse service records compared to that of the grievant. The claimants finally prayed the court to find that Mr. Chirunga's dismissal was wrongful and reinstate him back to duty.

In reply the respondents submitted that the grievant had been a habitual absentee. He was given the last warning on 4th December, 1987, to mend his ways, but he did not heed the warning. On 18th July and 3rd August, 1988, the grievant absented himself from duty without leave or reasonable excuse. The offences were committed within one year from the date of the last warning; and, in view of the grievant's past poor employment record, indicating five offences of similar nature, the respondents were left with no other alternative but to summarily dismiss him for habitual absenteeism. They emphatically maintained that the grievant's dismissal under regulation A. 2 (c) was proper because he did not absent himself for more than seven continuous days as required in terms of regulation G. 13 (e).

Regarding the records of the three ex-employees which were produced in court, the respondents told the court in brief that none of these cases was similar in nature to the grievant's case. After all, each case was decided on its own facts, circumstances and merits. The respondents, therefore, prayed the court to reject the claimants' demand as baseless because an award in their favour would amount to complete disregard of productivity targets and discipline.

The allegations made against the grievant in this dispute are generally conceded or undisputed by the parties, and the only question for consideration is whether the punishment of dismissal was in the circumstances unduly severe, excessive and unwarranted. The claimants' case is that the punishment accorded to the grievant exceeded the gravity of the offence, but the respondents urged that the grievant was a habitual absentee and had been warned several times in the past for such misconduct. In the circumstances, they argued, the court cannot, therefore, substitute its own punishment for that of the management.

In determining the exact punishment to be inflicted the factors invariably taken into consideration in the case of misconduct by an employee are the length of his service, the quality of service rendered by him and the gravity of the default or the dereliction of duty. Even if it is not said so in the order, these are the considerations which should prevail with an employer in determining the extent of punishment to be awarded. Therefore, if the employer refers to the past bad or unsatisfactory record of the employee with a view to determining the exact punishment to be awarded, it is within his competence and no legal defect on that score can be said to exist, provided his decision is not based on (i) victimization, (ii) unfair labour practice or want of good faith, (iii) violation of the principles of natural justice, (iv) completely baseless or perverse findings. Thus the management of a concern has absolute right to direct its own internal administration and discipline and the court has no jurisdiction to interfere with the exercise of the managerial power except on the ground mentioned above.

But howsoever extensive or unlimited the power possessed by the management to regulate its internal administration and discipline may be, it cannot take away the power of the court when a dispute has arisen, to examine for itself whether the termination or dismissal of an employee's services is justified or bona fide, and to give appropriate relief. If, for example, for the same offence the employer punishes an employee lightly and the other severely, and the difference cannot be explained, the court would obviously have the justification to interfere with the impugned order.

The facts of this case disclose that the grievant was actually guilty of habitual absence without leave, but on every occasion of his absence from duty he did not stay away for (7) continuous days so as to attract provisions of staff regulation G. 13 (c) and section 17 (a) of the Employment Act (Cap. 226). We are also convinced by the claimants' contention that the dismissal of the grievant was unjustified because three other ex-employees who had similar, if not worse, employment records of absenteeism had their services terminated on public interest, with full terminal benefits.

With the foregoing observations and after devoting our best attention to the facts and circumstances of this case, we are satisfied that the grievant's dismissal should be reduced to normal termination of service with full terminal benefits in terms of the parties' collective agreement in force at the time. We award accordingly.

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 29th January, 1991, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 28th May, 1991, together with statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

The grievants in this dispute Mr. King'oo and Mr. Yusuf were employed by the respondents on 1st August, 1984 and 11th March, 1985, respectively as machine operators.

At the time of their terminations Mr. King'oo and Mr. Yusuf were earning consolidated salaries of KSh. 1,609.35 and KSh. 3,000 per month respectively.

The parties tried on 17th May, 1990, to settle the matter amicably at their own level but failed. The dispute was then reported to the Minister for Labour. Thereafter, the dispute was investigated by the ministry and the findings and recommendations were released to the parties, on 29th November, 1990.

The ministry's findings were that the grievants were terminated on generalized accusations which had no basis.

The grievants were found to have suffered a wrongful termination.

The ministry recommended that the respondents should pay the grievants their terminal benefits as per collective agreement. In addition the grievants were to be paid each two (2) months salary by way of compensation for loss of employment they had suffered.

The decision was turned down by the respondents and the matter is now before the court for consideration.

The claimants submitted that the grievants had a very clean employment record. They did not have even a single warning on record in their files. The claimants stated that, in 1989 there was a change in the directorship of the company. The new directors were unhappy with the size of the labour force they found in the company and planned to have it reduced. The claimants explained that the respondents in order to reduce their staff had to use any means at their disposal. As a result, employees started to be accused of laxity, ignorance, and carelessness in their work.

The claimants prayed the court to award the grievants normal termination of service plus full compensation as follows:

- (a) Notice as per parties collective agreement.
- (b) Days worked.
- (c) Leave/pro-rata.
- (d) 12 months compensation for loss of employment.
- (e) Leave travelling allowance.
- (f) Ex gratia payment of 10 days pay per completed year of service as provided for in the collective bargaining agreement.

The respondents submitted that in the beginning of 1990 they had started incurring heavy losses due to poor quality hides received by the grievants on their behalf. As a result, the grievants were verbally cautioned and warned against improper grading of skins and hides.

The grievants did not take the warnings seriously.

The respondents emphasized that the grievants were not terminated on account of indirect redundancy but that they had acted dishonestly against the interests of the company by receiving poor quality hides and skins on behalf of the company and thereby jeopardizing their jobs and company's business.

The respondents urged the court to find that they had acted fairly in terminating the grievants services. They prayed the court to reject the claimants demands as baseless and uphold their action.

The court has carefully considered the parties submission and can find no justifiable reason why the services of the grievants should have been terminated. The fact that all the five graders lost their jobs for one reason or another coupled with the closure of respondents operations in the Industrial Area of Nairobi is a pointer that in some ways the respondents were engaged in a crude exercise of redundancy without trying to follow the laid down statutory procedures regarding redundancies.

The court finds that the two grievants have suffered a wrongful termination and awards that the respondents should pay the grievants the following compensation.

The two grievants should also be paid all their terminal benefits i.e. notice pay, leave pay, allowance, days worked and gratuity as specified in the parties collective agreement applicable at the time of their termination.

Criminal cases in all the subordinate courts will be heard as usual. Civil suits and civil matters of an urgent nature or those in which advocates are not engaged may also be heard in these courts.
