6. The buildings shall not cover a greater area of the land or such lesser area as may be laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.

7. The grantee shall not subdivide the land without the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands.

8. The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. 14. The Commissioner of Lands reserves the right to revise the annual ground rental payable hereunder after the expiration of ten (10) years of the term. The rental shall be at a rate to be determined by the Commissioner of Lands of the unimproved value of the land as at the end of every tenth (10th) year of the term.
