3. The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.

4. Should the grantee give notice in writing to the town council that he/she is unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the town council shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein:

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given—

- (a) within twelve (12) months of the actual registration of the lease, the town council shall refund to the grantee 50 per cent of the stand premium paid in respect of the land;
- (b) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the town council shall refund the grantee 25 per cent of the said stand premium; or

Box 30099, Nairobi (the licensee), intends to make an application on 3rd January, 1994, to the Minister for Energy under sections 72 and 149 of the Electric Power Act for approval by him of proposed by-laws to be known as the "Methods of Charge (K.P.L.C.) By-laws, 1994" which, if and when approved, will revoke the current Methods of Charge (K.P.L.C.) By-laws, 1993 (N6 2).

The period between 1987 and 1992 was characterised by persistent inflation and devaluation of the shilling against hard currencies in which the power industry has borrowed over the years for development. Coupled with delayed and inadequate tariff increases, the combined effect of these factors resulted in the industry experiencing a cumulative deficit of KSh. 1.2

billion by the end of the fiscal year 1991/92. The further devaluation of the shilling by over 100 per cent early this year, in the face of deteriorating inflation, exacerbated the industry's financial position. As a result, the three tariff increases implemented between April and September this year, notwithstanding, the industry projects a deficit of KSh. 2.5 billion by end of June 1994. This substantial deficit is attributable mainly to the increase in the cost of debt service, import of materials and equipment for expansion, rehabilitation, operation and maintenance of the system. Implementation of this programme is essential if the industry is to meet the high growth in demand associated with projected rapid recovery of the economy. Further, due to the influence of the above factors, the projected cost of new investments is substantially high. For instance, the cost of electricity from new investment is estimated at KSh. 7.09 per unit compared with the existing tariff yield of KSh. 2.79 in order for the industry to meet the economy's demand for electrical energy, the Company is compelled to seek progressive tariff increases consistent with high growth in financial demands.

The object of and reasons for the application are, therefore, to make the tariff structure and price levels more reflective of the cost of supply by raising the tariff and surcharges of power factor and welding equipment. The revised bye-laws are also tailored to facilitate automatic adjustment of prices to take account of changes in the cost of fuel used for generation. These measures are calculated to achieve an increase in revenue and to promote cost consciousness in the consumption of electricity.

The effect of the minister's approval of our application will be as outlined hereinafter. Firstly, on the prices of electricity, there will be an overall average tariff increase of 14 per cent ranging from 29 per cent to 92 per cent on all categories of consumers. Secondly, the surcharge imposed for poor power factor will increase from 1 per cent to 2 per cent for each complete 1 per cent by which the power factor is below 0.9 for consumers charged under Methods A, B, C and E. This change will not affect consumers under Method D. Thirdly, the fixed charge for electrical welding equipment will be adjusted from KSh. 425 per KVA to KSh. 50 per KVA per meter reading period. Finally, the price of electricity to all categories of consumers will be adjusted, when necessary, to reflect changes in the cost of fuel based generation arising from changes in the price of fuel. Details of the proposed tariff structure are contained in the proposed "Methods of Charge (K.P.L.C.) By-laws, 1994". These have been deposited at the office of the licensee and are open to public inspection during normal office hours without payment. Copies of the proposed bye-laws may be purchased at the office of the licensee at a price of KSh. 40 per copy.
