  - (iv) notify that trade union and the organization in writing within one (1) month of the payment,
  - (v) make written returns to the registrar of trade unions within one (1) month of making all the payments to that trade union and to the organization

Senior Housing Economist (Two Posts) (No 145/96)

Salary scale —K£5,694 to 8,127 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

#### Requirements for appointment

Applicants must in possession of a bachelor's degree in either land economics, building economics or economics (major) from a recognized university. They must in addition have saved satisfactorily in the grade of housing economist I for a minimum period of three years.

#### Duties and responsibilities

Chief Laboratory Technologist (One Post) (Re-advertiser tent) (No 257/95) (No 146/96)

Salary scale —K£5,694 to 8,127 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

# Requirements for appointment

Applicants must have served satisfactorily in the grade of senior laboratory technologist for at least three (3) years, and s iown initiative, competence and administrative capabilities in man iging laboratory services

### Duties and responsibilities

Work at this level involves management of laboratory services at a national research centre or station or headship of centralized laboratory services. In addition, the officer will be expected to ensure availability of laboratory supplies and equipment as well as undertaking technical evaluation of quotations and tenders for laboratory stores and services. Other duties will include supervision training and development of staff

Senior Laboratory Technologist (Three Posts) (No. 147.96)

Salary scale —K£4,827 to 7,140 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

# Requirements for appointment

Applicants must have completed at least three (3) years' satisfactory service as a laboratory technologist I and be in possession of the higher national diploma. They must have shown considerable capabilities and efficiency in management of la poratory work. Applicants without the higher national diploma must have served for a least five (5) years in the grade of laboratory technologist I

# Duties and responsibilities

Work at this level involve the management of labor, tory services in regional research centres or large sections in a national research centre or station with several laboratories. Specific duties include co-ordination of the provision of labor, tory services as well as allocation of duties and distribution of staff. He/she will be expected to do the actual bench work in his/her area of specialization either availability of laboratory equipment train and supervise staff under him

- (d) have shown administrative ability by being conversant with Government regulations Governing personnel, financial management, Government contract procedures and so on,

Be in possession of the national ordinary diploma in building and civil engineering from the Kenya National Examinations Council or technician certificate part III from Kenya National Examinations Council in building and civil engineering plus five (5) years' experience in the grade of senior structural assistant

### Duties and responsibilities

The chief structural assistant will assist the principal structural assistant in the day to day running of the drawing office and the supervision of works of projects on site. He will be responsible to the principal structural assistant for the drawing office equipment and supply of drawing materials, allocation of accommodation in the drawing office, checking drawings and pending schedules prepared by junior officers and compiling a weekly work output chart on all junior structural assistants dealing with civil/structural engineering design work. The officer will also check bills of quantities and documents related to contracts

Senior Quantity Survey Assistant (One Post) (No 150/96)

Salary scale —K£4,827 to 7,140 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

# Requirements for appointment

Applicants should have served in the grade of quantity survey assistant for a minimum period of three (3) years, be in possession of higher national diploma in building and civil engineering from the Kenya National Examinations Council and have shown merit and ability in work performance

OR

Be in possession of the national ordinary diploma in building and civil engineering from the Kenya National Examinations Council or technician certificate part III in building and civil engineering plus five years' experience in the grade of quantity survey assistant I in addition, the officer must have shown merit and competence as reflected in work performance

#### Duties and responsibilities

Duties and responsibilities are similar to those of the quantity survey assistant I but with greater volume and responsibility. In addition, he/she will deal with cost control, contract valuation, assist in the audit of final accounts relating to contracts and supervise staff

Chief Superintendent (Electrical) (Three Posts) (Re-advertisement) (No 98/95) (No 151/96)

Salary scale —K£5,694 to 8,127 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

#### Requirement for appointment

For appointment to the grade of chief superintendent (electrical) the officer must—

- (a) be in possession of the higher national diploma in electrical engineering from the Kenya National Examinations Council,
- (b) have served satisfactorily for at least three (3) years in the grade of senior superintendent (electrical),
- (c) have very wide knowledge and experience in all areas of electrical design and supply, installations, commissioning and testing, inspection and maintenance,
- (d) have the ability and knowledge to plan and direct electrical work, and
