(No. 10 of 2001)

THE SUGAR (IMPORTS, EXPORTS AND BY-PRODUCTS)
REGULATIONS, 2003
(L.N. 39 of 2003)

QUANTITIES OF SUGAR TO BE IMPORTED IN 2004

1. IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Regulation 6 of the Sugar (Imports, Exports and By-Products) Regulations, 2003, the Kenya Sugar Board directs that the quantities of sugar which may be imported into the country from member states of the Common Market for Eastern and Southern African States pursuant to the provisions of Legal Notice No. 12 of 2004 made under the Customs and Excise Act (Cap. 472), shall be as specified in the Schedule hereto.

2. The Kenya Sugar Board invites tenders from registered importers for the importation of the quantities of sugar specified.

3. Tenders shall specify—

- (a) the quantities intended to be imported by the individual registered importer; and
- (b) the intended period of importation,

and should be submitted to:

The Chief Executive Officer, Kenya Sugar Board, Sukari Plaza, Upper Kabete, off Waiyaki Way, P.O. Box 51500, Nairobi, so as to reach him not later than 5.00 p.m. on the 25th March, 2004.
