THE NATIONAL POLICE SERVICE ACT

(No. 11A of 2011)

DECLARATION OF CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE LOCATIONS OF
BUNGOMA COUNTY AS DISTURBED AND DANGEROUS AREA

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 106 (2) (a) of the National Police Service Act, and pursuant to Gazette Notice No. 2092 of 2018, declaring Cheptais Sub-county of Bungoma County as Disturbed and Dangerous Areas, the Inspector-General of Police notifies the general public that all inhabitants of the Sub-county are prohibited to possess any arms.

Upon publication of this Notice, all persons/inhabitants are ordered to surrender all arms in their possession with immediate effect to the nearest Police Station/Post/Camp or Administrative office during the hours of the day for safe custody.

This Notice shall take effect from the date of publication and shall remain in force for a period of ninety (90) days subject to revocation and/or extension.
