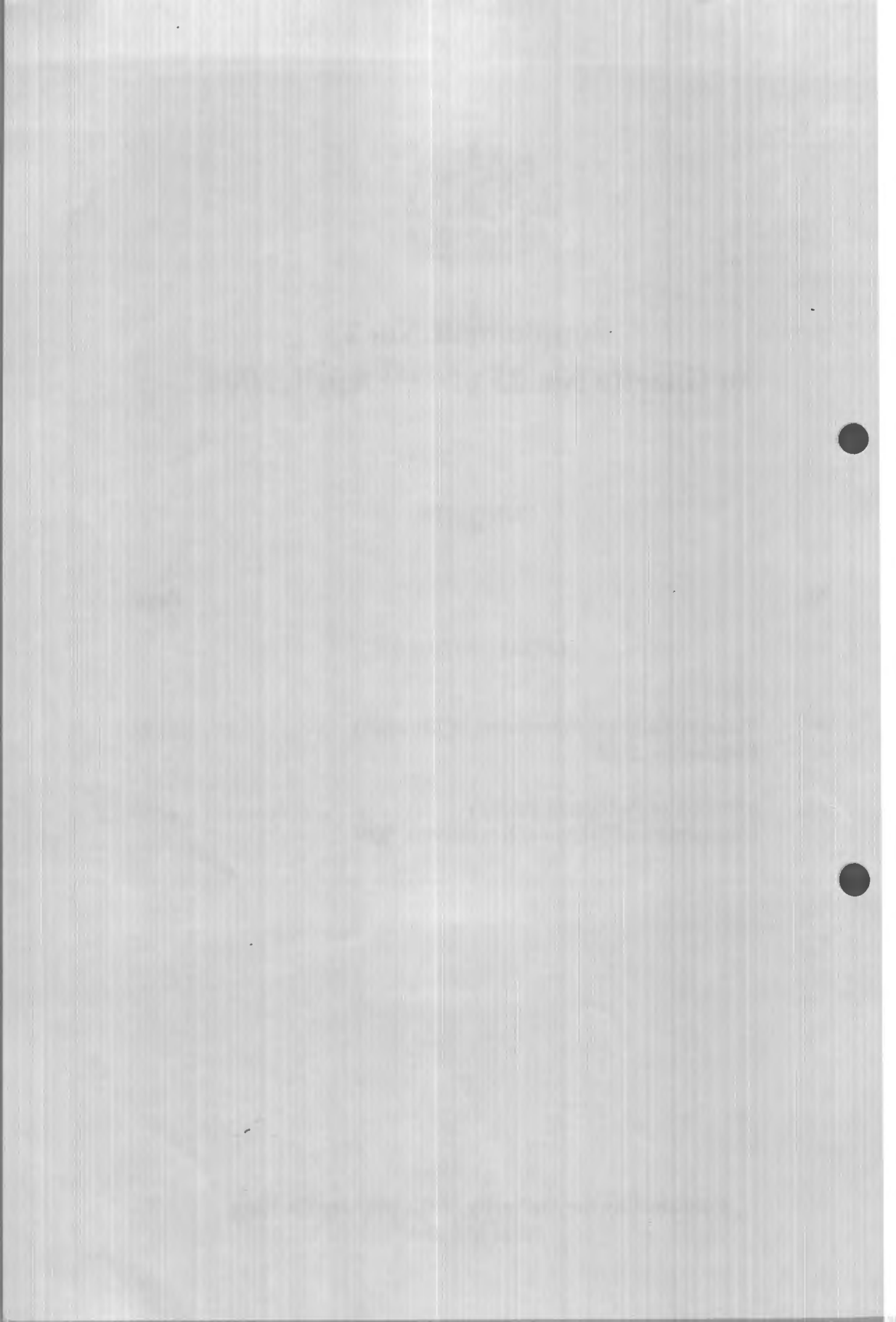

**Statutory Salaries (Amendment of Schedule)
Regulations, 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6A of the Statutory Salaries Act 1972¹, I,

PAKALITHA BETHUEL MOSISILI

Minister responsible for the Public Service, make the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statutory Salaries (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2006 and shall come into operation on 1 April, 2006

Repeal and replacement of Schedule 1

2. Schedule 1 to the Statutory Salaries Act 1972 is repealed and replaced with the following Schedule:

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 8(b) of the Members of Parliament Salaries Act 1998¹, and in consultation with the Minister of Finance, I,

Minister responsible for Parliamentary Affairs, make the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Members of Parliament Salaries (Amendment of Schedule) Regulations, 2006 and shall come into operation on 1 April, 2006

Repeal and replacement of Schedule 1

2. Schedule 1 to the Members of Parliament Salaries Act, 1998 is repealed and replaced with the following Schedule:
