**Declaration of Land set aside for Public purposes Ha Mokhele,
Mokhethoaneng Area Notice, 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 51 of the Land Act, 2010¹,
I,

TŠOINYANE RAPAPA

Minister responsible for local government, after having consulted with Kanana Community Council and field owners of Ha Mokhele, Mokhethoaneng Berea District hereby declare that the land described in this notice is set aside for public purposes.

Description: Every right or interest in and to the land (fields) described as agricultural land located on the West of Main North I road, at approximately twelve kilometres north of Maseru CBD. The area boundaries start at 'Maliemere Bridge on Old Maseru-TY road and stretches South-West whilst meandering alongside the Caledon River up to the eastern boundary of Plot No. 14253-10000. It then turns clockwise, towards the North-East, whilst passing through a dirt/unpaved road which separates Ha Mokhele and Libuping village. It stretches up to a point where Old Ha Mokhele village starts after bordering with Old Maseru-TY unpaved road, it then continues and borders with Old Ha Mokhele village in the North-East. It then continues Eastwards on an unpaved road on the foothills of Mokhethoaneng escarpment to Manganeng village in the East. At this point it stretches towards the donga which separates Ha Mokhele and Ha Foso settlement and goes back Southward to 'Maliemere Bridge in extent delineated on cadastral Plan No. 14253 held in the office of Chief Surveyor, Maseru in extent 1,329,455 square metres more or less situated at Ha Mokhele, Mokhethoane Berea District.

Lessee: Field owners of Ha Mokhele Berea District or their heirs.

Purposes: The land is required for Residential Estate Scheme.

Date of surrender: On the date of Publication of this Notice in the Gazette, all interests in or affecting the said land shall cease to subsist and the allottees' interest in the land shall revert to the State.

Compensation: Compensation is estimated at Thirty-eight Million, Five Hundred and Fifty-four Thousand, One Hundred and Ninety-five Maloti (M38,554,195) or more or less and shall be apportioned to the claims accordingly.

Claims: Any person having any claim in the land so set aside may submit his claim for compensation to the Minister by forwarding the details thereof to the Commissioner of Lands, P.O. Box 876 Maseru 100 for onward transmission to the Managing Director, Lesotho Housing and Land Development Corporation, P.O. Box 460 Maseru 100 within three (3) months of the date of publication of this notice in the Gazette.
