Community Council Notice, 2023**

Pursuant to section 51 of the Land Act, 2010¹, I,

Minister responsible for local government and chieftainship after having consulted with Matsoku Community Council hereby declare land in this Notice as land set aside for public interest:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Declaration of Land set aside for Public interest at Matsoku Community Council Notice, 2023 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Gazette.

**DESCRIPTION: SELECTED DEVELOPMENT AREA (SDA) AT HA
THEKO QUARRY MINING SITE**

The border starts on the north-east of Ha Theko Moreneng below (West) of the Northern Access Road (Hlotse to Katse) and proceeds on the East to the first gorge (Khohloana) on the southern side of Ha Theko Moreneng to the Katse Dam banks moving along the borders of Thoteng Ha Ntsu on the south-eastern to the north-western side along the borders of Thoteng (Ntate Motheosa's field) into the gorge and moving south below Ha Theko Thoteng (Matebeleng) village towards the border of quarry 5 and running in north-eastern direction towards Ha Theko Moreneng on the north-western side and back to the Northern Access Road.

LESSEE: Field and plot owners of Matsoku Community Council.

PURPOSE: The Land is required for the implementation of Phase 2 of the Lesotho Highlands Water Project. This involves, among others, the construction of new dam, the Polihali Dam, and other works such as work camps, feeder roads around the dam, installation of power lines and communication lines and other relevant ancillary services and facilities and digging up quarries. The project will also include the construction of an underground tunnel to transfer water to the Katse Dam.
