General Notice No. 148 of 2018

POLICE COMMUNIQUE

Prohibition to fly/operate a Remotely Piloted Aircraft (Drone) in the regions of Grand Bassin

The public is hereby informed that pursuant to the Civil Aviation (Amendment) Regulations 2016 (GN 139 of 2016), it is strictly prohibited to fly or operate a Remotely Piloted Aircraft (such as Drones) over a congested area except with the authority granted by the Director of the Civil Aviation Department.

2. With a view to ensuring the safety and security of pilgrims and other persons converging to Ganga Talao, Grand Bassin in connection with the Maha Shivaratree Festival 2018, NO PERSON shall fly/operate a Remotely Piloted Aircraft (Drones) over regions where there are processions and gatherings including the whole area of Grand Bassin between 09.02.2018 and 13.02.2018, unless permission has been obtained from the Director of Civil Aviation.

3. The flying or operating of Remotely Piloted Aircraft (Drones) in the abovementioned regions without the permission of the Director of Civil Aviation constitutes an offence under the Civil Aviation Regulations 2007 (as amended), for which the offender may be liable to a fine not exceeding Rs 10,000 and imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months

POLICE NOTICE

CHINESE SPRING FESTIVAL 2018

Defile and Cultural Programme in Port Louis on Wednesday 14th February, 2018

In virtue of Section 25 (3) of the Police Act and Section 181 of the Road Traffic Act, traffic arrangements as hereunder will be made on the occasion of the Chinese Festival on **Wednesday 14th February, 2018** as from **15.00 hrs to 19.00 hrs** in connection with the above event.

2. CLOSED ROADS

- (i) Jummah Mosque Street from corner Remy Ollier Street up to Queen Street except for devotees attending prayer at Jummah Mosque;
- (ii) Joseph Riviere Street from corner Farquhar up to Royal Street, Port Louis;
- (iii) Emmanuel Anquetil Street from corner Remy Ollier up to Royal Street, Port Louis; and
- (iv) Royal Street from its junction with Louis Pasteur Street up to junction of Dr. Sun Yat Sun Street.

3. DIVERSION OF TRAFFIC

- (i) Vehicular traffic coming from the South along Royal Street, Port Louis will be diverted onto Louis Pasteur Street or adjoining roads;
- (ii) Northern bound buses, leaving immigration Square will either to do via New Trunk Road or use Farquhar Street, Louis Pasteur Street, Sir Seewoosagar Ramgoolam Street, Sir Edgar Laurent Street and Nicolay Road; and
- (iii) Vehicular traffic may either be required to hold temporarily or diverted as required by Police with a view to ensuring the safe passage of the defile.

4. NO PARKING

Parking of vehicles will be prohibited along the stretch of Royal Street from its junction with Louis Pasteur Street up to Dr. Sun Yat Sen Street, Port Louis.

5. TAXI STAND

The Emmanuel Taxi Stand will not be operational and instead will move along Dr. Sun Yat Sen Street.

6. MUSIC

The defile may be accompanied by music, silence shall however be observed when the defile will pass any place of worship or when ordered to do so by Police.

7. JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Non compliance with these traffic arrangements will entail judicial proceedings.

The cooperation and understanding of the public would be much appreciated.
