(CAP.55:01)

EMPLOYMENT (APPRENTICES, CRAFTSMEN AND TRADESMEN)  
REGULATIONS, 2017

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 67 of the Employment Act, I, HENRY MUSSA, Minister of Labour, Youth, Sports and Manpower Development, make the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment Act (Apprentices, Craftsmen and Tradesmen) Regulations, 2017, and shall come into operation on 10th March, 2017. Citation

Grade 3 Certificates	Background text shall be printed in cream colour on A4 Paper of 160gsm, bearing serial certificate numbers, Court of Arms and a generic silver hologram. Some Ultraviolet (UV) text and micro text shall be hidden.
Grade 2 Certificates	Background texts shall be printed in green colour on A4 paper of 160gsm, bearing serial certificate numbers, Court of Arms and a generic silver hologram. Some Ultraviolet (UV) text and micro text shall be hidden.
Grade 1 Certificates	Background text shall be printed in red colour on A4 paper of 160gsm, bearing serial certificate numbers, Court of Arms and a generic silver hologram. Some Ultraviolet (UV) text and micro text shall be hidden.

## CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (TARIFFS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2017

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 83(1) of the Customs and Excise Act, I, GOODALL EDWARD GONDWE, Minister of Finance, Economic Planning and Development make the following Order—

Citation 1. This Order may be cited as Customs and Excise (Tariffs) (Amendment) Order, 2017.
