#### STOCK THEFT ACT, 1990: EXEMPTION OF DULY LICENSED AUCTIONEERS HOLDING PUBLIC AUCTIONS IN CERTAIN SPECIFIED AREAS

Under the powers vested in me by section 21(2) of the Stock Theft Act, 1990 (Act 12 of 1990), I hereby exempt, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule A, any duly licensed auctioneer who sells stock to any other person at a public auction held in any area set out in Schedule B, from compliance with the provisions of sections 6(1)(a)(i) and (ii), (1)(b) and (1A) of the said Act.

#### SCHEDULE A

A duly licensed auctioneer shall in the document of identification to be furnished in terms of section 6(1) of the Stock Theft Act, 1990, in addition to the particulars referred to in sections 6(1)(a)(iii) and (iv), also state -

- (a) his or her own name;
- (b) the place where the stock was sold in public auction; and
- (c) the number and sex of such stock.

#### SCHEDULE B

1. The areas known as Namaland, as defined in Schedule 1 to the Namaland Consolidation and Administration Act, 1972 (Act 79 of 1972), as amended by the Namaland Consolidation and Administration Amendment Proclamation, 1978 (Proclamation AG. 39 of 1978), the Namaland Consolidation and Administration Amendment Act, 1979 (Act 15 of 1979), the Namaland Consolidation and Administration Amendment Proclamation, 1980 (Proclamation AG. 71 of 1980), and the Namaland Consolidation and Administration Amendment Act, 1986 (Act 4 of 1986).

- 2. The area defined in Schedule B to Government Notice 2428 of 1972, as amended by Government Notice AG. 9 of 1979 and known as Damaraland.
- 3. The areas defined in Schedule E to Government Notice 2428 of 1972, as amended by Government Notice 322 of 1976 and known as Hereroland East Area 1 and Hereroland East Area 2.
- 4. The area defined in Schedule B to Government Notice 1196 of 1970 and known as Hereroland West.
- 5. The Ovitoto Reserve as defined in paragraph (3) of the Second Schedule to Government Notice 122 of 1923 and extended by Government Notices 173 of 1933, 182 of 1937 and 46 of 1938 and the Native Reserves Ordinance, 1960 (Ordinance 23 of 1960), but excluding the land exised therefrom by Proclamation 248 of 1962.

#### MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT, 1951: ACCEPTANCE OF TONNAGE OF SHIPS AS DENOTED IN THEIR CERTIFICATES OF REGISTRY OR OTHER NATIONAL PAPERS ISSUED IN COUNTRIES WHICH HAVE ACCEDED TO THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON TONNAGE MEASUREMENT OF SHIPS, 1969, FOR PURPOSES OF REGISTERING OF SHIPS IN NAMIBIA

Under section 18 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1951 (Act 57 of 1951), I hereby direct that ships registered in countries which have acceded to the International Convention on Tonnage Measurement of Ships, 1969, shall without being resurveyed in Namibia be presumed to be of the tonnage denoted in their certificates of registry or other national papers, in the same manner, to the same extent and for the same purposes as the tonnage denoted in the certificate of registry of a Namibian ship is presumed to be the tonnage of that ship and that the space shown by the certificate of registry or other national papers of any ship registered in any such country, as deducted from tonnage on account of being occupied by seamen or apprentice-officers and appropriated to their use, shall for the purpose of determining her tonnage be presumed to have been certified by a surveyor under subsection (2) of section 262 of the said Act to comply with those of the provisions of the said Act which apply to such a space in the case of a Namibian ship.

PROPOSAL THAT A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1 BE DEVIATED AND PROPOSED INCREASE OF THE WIDTH OF ROAD RESERVE OF A PORTION OF TRUNK ROAD 6/1: DISTRICT OF WINDHOEK

It is hereby made known -
