AMENDMENT OF SEA FISHERIES REGULATIONS

The Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources has under section 32 of the Sea Fisheries Act, 1992 (Act 29 of 1992) made the regulations set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

The Sea Fisheries Regulations promulgated by Government Notice No. 1 of 1993 and amended by Government Notice No. 204 of 1994, are hereby amended by the substitution for regulation 31 of the following regulation:

"31. (1) With the exception of biodegradable household waste, biodegradable waste generated on a fishing vessel in the course of fish processing and unused bait, all waste shall be taken back to port and no such waste shall be disposed of at sea.

(2) Any waste taken back to port as required by subregulation (1) shall be disposed of both in compliance with such requirements as may be stipulated by any other law or any competent authority and to the satisfaction of the Permanent Secretary.

(3) No waste emanating from a fishing vessel which may be disposed of in the sea in terms of subregulation (1) shall be disposed of within a distance of five nautical miles from the low-water line."
