SEA FISHERIES ACT, 1992 INCREASE OF TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH IN RESPECT OF ROCK LOBSTER

In terms of section 15 of the Sea Fisheries Act, 1992 (Act No. 29 of 1992), and after consultation with the Sea Fisheries Advisory Council, I hereby determine that the Total Allowable Catch in respect of rock lobster for the allocation of quotas during the 2000/2001 rock lobster season commencing on 1 November 2000 and ending on 30 April 2001, as specified in Government Notice No. 271 of 2000 shall be increased from 350 metric tons to 400 metric tons. The said 400 metric tons shall be allocated in relation to each area mentioned in the first column of the table set out below, for the purpose of allocating quotas in respect of the period specified opposite such area in the second column of that table and be apportioned as specified opposite such area in the third column of that table:

AMENDMENT OF REGULATIONS UNDER MEDICINES AND RELATED SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT, 1965

The Minister of Health and Social Services has under section 35(1) and (3)(b) of the Medicines and Related Substances Control Act, 1965 (Act No. 101 of 1965) amended

the regulations promulgated under Government Notice No. 352 of 1975 by the substitution for regulation 2 of the following regulation:

“Application for registration of a medicine

2. (1) Application for registration of a medicine may be made -
 - (a) by a pharmacist;
 - (b) by a body corporate registered with the Pharmacy Board to carry on business as a pharmacist under section 25 of the Pharmacy Professions Act, 1993 (Act No. 23 of 1993), or a person authorized by such body corporate to act on its behalf;
 - (c) in the case of medicine manufactured by a person registered as a pharmaceutical manufacturer in a foreign country by a competent regulatory authority of that country, that manufacturer; or
 - (d) in the case of medicine manufactured by a person who is the holder of a permit issued under section 22A(13) of the Act, that person.
- (2) An applicant referred to in subregulation (1)(c) must produce satisfactory proof to the Council -
 - (a) of its registration as a pharmaceutical manufacturer by the competent medicines regulatory authority of the country concerned; and
 - (b) that it holds a current certificate of good manufacturing practice issued by that medicines regulatory authority.
- (3) In relation to an applicant referred to in subregulation (1)(c), the Council may make such investigations, or cause such investigations to be made, as it deems necessary to establish any fact contemplated in subregulation (2).”

- (c) An applicant must be informed in writing of the outcome of his or her application.
- (d) The closing date for the applications is 30 days from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*.

4. Minimum qualifications required to qualify for allotment

An applicant (other than a company or close corporation contemplated in section 41(7) of the Agricultural Commercial Land Reform Act, 1995 (Act No. 6 of 1995)) must be a Namibian citizen who -

- (a) is 18 years of age or older but not older than 70 years;
- (b) has a background or interest in agriculture or related enterprises;
- (c) has been socially, economically or educationally disadvantaged by past discriminatory laws or practices;
- (d) has relinquished any right in respect of agricultural land.

5. Rent payable in respect of farming units

A farming unit is to be leased for 99 years. The approximate rent payable monthly, in respect of a farming unit so leased for livestock farming, is N\$1,50 per head of cattle and N\$0,50 per head of small livestock.

6. Lease agreement
