#### AMENDMENT OF ELECTRICITY SUPPLY REGULATIONS

The Council of the Municipality of Omaruru under section 30(1)(u) of the Local Authorities Act, 1992 (Act No. 23 of 1992) further amends the tariffs in the Electricity Supply Regulations Promulgated under all previous General Notices as set out in the Schedule.

#### **SCHEDULE**

Substitute the following paragraph for paragraph (c) 5:

# **ELECTRICITY TARIFFS**

#### **TARIFF 1- DOMESTIC**

For the supply of electricity at low voltage to all *bona fide* domestic consumers who use current for purposes of a domestic nature in private dwellings, flats or room:

- 1. Demand charge
  - Each consumer shall pay a monthly demand charge in accordance with the following scale based on the nominal rating(s) of the Municipal miniature circuit breaker(s) through which all current consumed at the consumer's installation shall pass.
  - (a) For single phase connections with miniature circuit breaker rating of: 15 amp. N\$33.34 vat excluded over 15 amp. N\$33.34 plus N\$2.22 per amp. above 15 amp vat excluded.
  - (b) For two and three phase connections the ampere ratings of the controlling main circuit breakers on each phase shall be added together and the charge, which shall be made on the summated ratings, shall be as for tariff 1(a).
- 2. Unit charge
  - In addition to the demand charge, all units consumed shall be charged at .364221c per unit consumed, vat excluded.
- 3. Minimum charge
  - The minimum monthly charge shall be equal to the demand charge as provided for in paragraph (1) of Tariff 1.

#### TARIFF 2 SMALL AND MEDIUM CONSUMERS

Applicable to all low voltage consumers (except domestic consumers) for power and lighting purposes, where no other tariff is applicable.

- 1. Demand charge
  - (a) Each consumer shall pay a monthly demand charge in accordance with the following scale which is based on the nominal rating of the Municipal miniature circuit breaker(s), through which all current consumed in the consumer's installation passes 15 amp. N\$58.32 plus N\$3.90 per amp above 15 amp. Vat excluded.
  - (b) The maximum permissible summated circuit breaker rating in terms of this tariff is 180 ampere, or 60 ampere per single-phase circuit breaker.

2. Unit charges

In addition to the demand charge, all units consumed shall be charges at .56c per unit, vat excluded.

3. Minimum charge

The monthly minimum charge shall be equal to the demand charge as defined in paragraph (1) of Tariff 2.

#### TARIFF 3 - BULK CONSUMERS

For the supply of electricity at low of medium voltage to bulk consumers with a minimum demand of 30 kva:

1. Demand charge

Each consumer shall pay a monthly demand charge, calculated as follow:

- (a) Where a KVA maximum demand meter is installed, the monthly demand charge shall be N\$37.51 per KVA or part thereof registered during any period of 30 minutes during the month by means of a type approved by the Town Electrical Engineer vat excluded.
- (b) Where in the opinion of the Town Electrical Engineer it is advantageous to use miniature circuit breakers in place of a maximum demand meter, the monthly demand charge shall be N\$3.38 per ampere of summated circuit breaker rating, with a minimum summated rating of 180 ampere, Vat excluded.
- 2. Unit charges

Over and above the demand charge, units consumed shall be paid for at the rate of -.2585c per unit, vat excluded.

3. Minimum charge

The monthly minimum charge shall be equal to the demand charge as defined in paragraph (1) of Tariff 3, provided that, in the case of paragraph (1)(a), the minimum charge shall be based on demand of 30 KVA.

#### **TARIFF 4**

For the supply of electricity at low voltage for power and lighting purposes to small single phase consumers, where the consumer or owner elects to charged under this tariff.
