#### ELECTORAL ACT, 1992: ELECTION FOR THE REHOBOTH URBAN WEST CONSTITUENCY IN THE HARDAP REGION: PUBLICATION OF CANDIDATES, POLLING DAYS AND POLLING STATIONS
