On the occasion of the retirement of Captain the Right Honourable Oliver Lyttelton, P.C., D.S.O., M.C., M.P. and the appointment of the Right Honourable Alan Lennox-Boyd, M.P., the following exchange of telegrams is published for information:—
To the Acting Governor from the retiring Secretary of State, dated the 29th of July, 1954.

No. 7. It is with keen regret that I lay down the office of Secretary of State for the Colonies. In these three years I have been able to visit many of the Colonial Territories and to meet both here and overseas a large number of people from all parts of the world. I have been fortunate to make a great many friends of all races during my term of office and I have learned much about difficult problems and golden opportunities which face you all. All that I have seen and done has confirmed my deep faith in the wisdom and rightness of the far-sighted policy for Colonial Territories to which all parties in Great Britain subscribe. I am certain social progress, economic prosperity and political advancement will grow and flourish in Colonial Territories if we work together and are patient with each other. Now I have to say good-bye and thank I know at first hand all the devoted work which the Colonial Service in all its branches and many men and women outside Government service are patiently pursuing. I wish all of them unqualified success in one of the greatest tasks which can fall to statesmen and administrators. My regret at leaving is only mitigated by my confidence in my successor. LENNOX-BOYD has served with me as Minister of State and he is a true friend of the peoples of the Colonial Territories. I send to you all my warmest thanks and my best wishes for the future.

To the retiring Secretary of State for the Colonies from the Acting Governor, dated the 31st of July, 1954.

No. 1177. I am most grateful for your message on the occasion of your relinquishing office as Secretary of State for the Colonies, news of which has been received with profound regret by your many friends in Nigeria. On behalf of the Government, the Public Service and the Peoples of Nigeria and on my own behalf I convey to you our deep gratitude for your unsparing and successful endeavours to further the political, social and economic advancement of this country and in particular your invaluable personal contribution to that end during your chairmanship of the Constitutional Conferences in London and Lagos.
